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A. CLASSIFICATION UNDER CHAPTER 84.34 RCW. I/we request that this land retain the current use classification as [] Open Space Land, [] Farm and Agricultural Land, [] Timberland, and I am/we are aware of the following use classification of the land:

1. OPEN SPACE LAND MEANS EITHER:

- any land area so designated by an official comprehensive land use plan adopted by any city or county and zoned accordingly; or
- any land area, the preservation of which in its present use would: (i) conserve and enhance natural or scenic resources; (ii) protect streams or water supply; (iii) promote conservation of soils, wetlands, beaches, or tidal marshes; (iv) enhance the value to the public of abutting or neighboring parks, forests, wildlife preserves, nature reservations or sanctuaries or other open space; (v) enhance recreation opportunities; (vi) preserve historic sites; (vii) preserve visual quality along highway, road, and street corridors or scenic vistas; or (viii) retain in its natural state tracts of land not less than one acre situated in an urban area and open to public use on such classification; or
- any land that meets the definition of farm and agricultural conservation land. "Farm and agricultural conservation land is either: (i) land that was previously classified as open space farm and agricultural land that no longer meets the criteria of farm and agricultural land, and that is reclassified as open space and under RCW 84.34.020(i); or (ii) land that is traditional farmland that is not classified under chapter 84.33 or 84.34 RCW, that has not been irrevocably devoted to a use inconsistent with agricultural uses, and that has a high potential for returning to commercial

2. FARM AND AGRICULTURAL LAND MEANS EITHER:

- a) any land in contiguous ownership of twenty or more acres devoted: (i) primarily to the production of livestock or agricultural commodities, for commercial purposes; or (ii) enrolled in the federal conservation reserve program or its successor administered by the United States department of agriculture; or (iii) other similar commercial activities as may be established by rule; or
- b) any parcel of land at least five acres but less than twenty acres devoted primarily to agricultural uses and produces a gross income equal to two hundred dollars or more per acre per year for chapter 84.24 RCW; or
- any parcel of land that is less than five acres devoted primarily to agricultural uses and produces a gross income equal to fifteen hundred dollars or more per year for three out of the five calendar years preceding the date of application for classification under chapter 36.34 RCW; or
- any land on which the principal place of residence of the farm operato, or owner of land or housing for employees is sited if the classified farm and agricultural land is classified pursuant to subsection (a) of this section, if the residence or housing is on or contiguous to the classified parcel, and the use of the residence or housing is integral to the use of the classified land for

Agricultural land also includes (i) land on which appurtenances necessary for the production, preparation, or sale of commercial agricultural products are situated when the appurtenances are used activity or enterprise that is compatible with commercial agricultural purposes as long as the incidental use does not exceed twenty percent of the classified land, and (iii) any noncontiguous parcel of land from one to five acres in size that constitutes an integral part of the commercial agricultural operations of a classified parcel of farm and agricultural land.

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TIMBER LAND MEANS any land in contiguous ownership of five or more acres devoted primarily to the growing and harvesting of forest crops for commercial purposes and not classified as reforestation land pursuant to Chapter 84.28 RCW. Timber land means the land only.

I/we declare that I am/we are aware of the liability of withdrawal or removal of this land from classification

- 1. If the owner has filed the proper notice of request to withdraw the classified land and the land has been classified for a minimum of ten years he/she shall pay an amount equal to the difference between the tax computed on the basis of "current use" and the fax computed on the basis of true and fair value plus interest at the same statutory rate charged on delinquent property taxes. The additional tax and interest shall be paid for the preceding seven years.
- 2. If land is removed from classification because of a change to a non-conforming use, land is removed prior to the minimum ten year period, or land is removed because the owner(s) failed to comply with the two year notice of withdrawal he'she shall be liable to pay the additional tax and interest described in I above plus a penalty of twenty percent of the additional tax and interest. The additional tax, interest, and penalty shall be paid for the preceding seven years.
- The additional tax, interest, and/or penalty shall not be imposed if the withdrawal or removal from classification resulted solely from:
 - a) transfer to a government entity in exchange for other land located within the state of Washington;
 - a taking through the exercise of the power of eminent domain, or sale or transfer to an entity having the power of eminent domain in anticipation of the exercise of this power, said entity having manifested its intent in writing or by other official action;
 - c) a natural disaster such as a flood, windstorm, earthquake, or other calamity rather than by virtue of the act of the landowner changing the use of the classified land;
 - official action by an agency of the state of Washington or by the county or city within which the land is located that disallows the present classified use of the land;
 - transfer of land to a church when the land would qualify for exemption pursuant to RCW
 - acquisition of property interests by a state or federal agency, county, city, town, metropolitan park district, metropolitan municipal corporation, nonprofit historic preservation corporation as defined in RCW 64.04.130, or nonprofit nature conservancy corporation or association as defined in RCW 84.34.250; or
 - removal of classified farm and agricultural land on which the principal residence of the farm operator or owner or housing for employees.
- (B) CLASSIFICATION UNDER CHAPTER 84.33 RCW. I/we request that this land retain its classification or designation as forest land and I am/we are aware of the following definition of forest

FOREST LAND means and is synonymous with timberland and means all land in contiguous ownership of at least twenty acres that is primarily devoted to and used for growing and harvesting timber. Forest

- a) CLASSIFIED FOREST LAND is land whose highest and best use is the growing and harvesting
- DESIGNATED FOREST LAND is land that is primarily devoted to and used for growing and harvesting timber but whose value for other purposes may be greater than its value for use as

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I/we declare that I am/we are aware of the liability of removal of this land from classification or designation and upon removal a compensating tax shall be imposed that shall be equal to the difference between the amount of tax last levied on the land as forest land and an amount equal to the new assessed valuation of the land multiplied by the millage rate of the last levy extended against the land, multiplied by a number, not greater than ten, equal to the number of years the land was classified or designated as forest

The compensating tax shall not be imposed if the removal of classification or designation resulted

- a) transfer to a government entity in exchange for other forest land located within the state of
- a taking through the exercise of the power of eminent domain, or sale or transfer to an entity having the power of eminent domain in anticipation of the exercise of this power;
- c) a donation of fee title, development rights, or the right to harvest timber, to a government agency or organization qualified under RCW 84.34.210 and 64.04.130 for the purposes enumerated in or organization qualified under NCW 64.34.210 and 04.04.130 for the purposes enumerated those sections or the sale or transfer of fee title to a governmental entity or a nonprofit nature conservancy corporation, as defined in RCW 64.04.130, exclusively for the protection and conservation of lands recommended for state natural area preserve purposes by the natural heritage council and natural heritage plan as defined in Chapter 79.70 RCW; or
- the sale or transfer of fee title to the parks and recreation commission for park and recreation

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EXHIBIT A.

PARCEL I

That portion of the B.B. Bishop D. L. C., in Section 16, 17 and 20, Township 2 North, Range 7 East of the Willamette Meridian, described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the West line of the said Section 16 with the Northerly line of the county Road known as the Moffetts-Carpenter Road; thence following the Northerly line of the said road in a Northerly and Easterly direction to intersection with the Westerly line of the 300 foot strip of land acquired by the United States of America for the Bonneville Power Administration's Electric Power Transmission Lines; thence following the Westerly line of said 300-foot strip of land to intersection with the North line of said Bishop D.L.C.; thence West along the North line of said Bishop D.L.C. to the Northwest corner thereof; thence South along the West line of said Bishop D.L.C. to the Northerly line of the said Moffetts-Carpenter Road; thence Easterly along the North line of said road to the point of beginning: EXCEPT the following tract of land:

Beginning at the intersection of the North line of the said Bishop D. L. C. with the Westerly line of said 300 foot strip of land acquired by the United States of America; thence South 32 degrees, 27' 30" West 754.95 feet, more or less, to the Northerly line of said Moffetts-Carpenter Road; thence in a Northwesterly direction following the Northerly line of said road to intersection with the center line of the right of way granted to the Northwestern Electric Company; thence in a Northeasterly direction following the center line of said right of way to intersection with the North line of the said Bishop D. L. C.; thence East to the point of beginning.

PARCEL II

That portion of Government Lots 8 and 9 of Section 16, Township 2 North, Range 7 East of the Willamette Meridian, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point marking the intersection between the center of Greenleaf Creek and the South line of the said Government Lot 9, said point being located on the North line of the B.B. Bishop D. L. C.; thence following the center of Greenleaf Creek in a Northeasterly direction to a point in the said Government Lot 8 North 430 feet from the North line of the said Bishop D. L. C. to intersection with the West line of the said Government Lot 9; thence South to the North line of said Bishop D. L. C.; thence Easterly along the North line of said Bishop D. L. C. to the Point of Beginning.
