6. I attempted to go to work at the employment office on Monday morning via the driveway the runs just west of the wastewater treatment plant. There were several trucks completely blocking all passage. I then went to enter via the driveway that runs in front of Rock Creek Day Care center. There were no wooden barricades up like there had been on previous days or any indication this area was blocked to vehicles. I drove very slowly, about 3-5 miles per hour. As I passed in front of Senior Services the planks that were supposed to be covering a ditch that had been created for laying pipes were inverted and not lying flat over the ditch. I drove over them, as it would have been very awkward to try to back my way out of this area. Immediately upon crossing them I heard a clicking sound as I drove about 30 feet to a parking spot. I looked at the front left tire, where I'd heard the sound, and saw nothing.

When I came out at lunchtime my tire was completely flat. I had the tire repaired at the Texaco station. There was a rock that had been chipped and chiseled, I believe by the ditch digging equipment, into the shape of a spike that had penetrated the tire. Jack at Texaco, said to watch it a few days to see if it would leak. Within a couple of days it was obviously leaking. I had to buy a new tire.

I feel that the driveway should not have been open that day. In addition to the planks not being flat, there was quite a bit of mud, rocks and construction debris had not been sufficiently cleared from this driveway area.
