NOTICE HEREBY IS GIVEN that the undersigned locators, each a citizen of the United States or one who has declared an intention to become such, have discovered a vein or lode of locatable mineral-bearing rock in place upon the public domain of the United States which is open to mineral entry and location within the above state, county and mining district; and, in accordance with the laws of the United States and of the State of Wash. have located and do hereby locate a claim upon such vein or lode by posting this notice of such discovery and location on a substantial post or monument at the point of discovery. The name of the claim is:

FIRLOCK II (LORE OF QUARTZ IN PLACE)
Commencing at post marked # 1 at the discovery point and then 600 feet in a N 10° W direction to an end post marked # 2, then 300 feet in a S 80° W direction to corner post # 3, then 600 feet in a S 10° E direction, then 900 feet in a S 30° E direction to corner post # 4, then 600 feet in a N 80° E direction to corner post # 5, then 900 feet in a N 30° W direction, then 600 feet in a N 10° W direction to corner post # 6, then 300 feet in a S 80° W direction to said end post # 2.

The locators claim 600 feet in a N 10° W direction from the point of discovery to the North end line and 900 feet in the opposite direction from the point of discovery to the South end line and 300 feet on each side of the middle of said vein or lode, further claiming all the surface rights, privileges and minerals, with all dips, spurs, angles and variations, and other rights granted by existing laws and customs. This claim is further described as being 3960 feet from the following natural object or permanent monument in the vicinity: The south end line is below the Boulder creek falls approximately 3/4 miles upstream from Forest Service road N90, in the Gifford Pinchot National Forest. Boulder Creek is the approx. center line of the claim.

The general course or strike of the vein or lode as nearly as may be determined is located in Boulder Creek with reference to the natural object or permanent monument described above.

This claim is situated in the NE (designate quarter section) of Section 26, Township 9 North, Range 9 East, of the West Meridian, as surveyed by the U.S. Government or protracted if the land is unsurveyed unsurveyed maps show that this might be in the SE 1/4 of section 23 and/or the NE 1/4 section of section 26. Most probably it's in section 26.

The end lines of the claim are parallel to each other. The adjoining claims are Firlock Lode located contiguously on the North end line.

This notice is placed conspicuously at the discovery post, and posts are placed at each corner of the claim. The location of this claim is distinctly marked on the ground so that the boundaries of the claim may be readily traced.
