


## OCTOBER 11,2000

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY WAS TO LOCATE THE WEST LINE OF THE NW I/4 AND THE NORTH LINE OF SECTION 4. THE SURVEY WAS DONE WITH LEICA 399 GPS RECIEVERS AND A LEICA TC805 TOTAL STATION. TERTIARY GPS CONTROL POINTS WERE ESTABLISHED NEAR THE SW SECTION CORNER, THE NW SECTION CORNER AND THE EAST I/4 CORNER. THE NE SECTION CORNER WAS OCCUPIED WITH A GPS RECIEVER. THE SW SECTION CORNER WAS TIED BY TRAVERSE FROM THE GPS CONTROL. A TRAVERSE WAS RUN FROM GPS CONTROL ALONG THE WEST AND NORTH LINES OF SECTION 4 AND CLOSED ON THE NE SECTION CORNER. THE NORTH AND WEST I/4 CORNERS WERE DETERMINED LOST AND WERE ESTABLISHED BY SINGLE PROPORTION.
