(c) Calculation of Changes

Before each Change Date, the Lender will calculate my new interest rate by adding
Six and Three Fourths percentage point(s) (6.750
to the Current Index. The Lender will then round the result of this addition to the nearest one-eighth of one percentage point (0.125%). Subject to the limits stated in Section 1(d) on the following page, this rounded amount will be the new interest rate until the next Change Date.

The Lender will then determine the amount of the monthly payment that would be sufficient to repay the unpaid principal balance as of the Change Date in full on the Maturity Date at the new interest rate in substantially equal payments. The result of this calculation will be the new monthly payment.

(d) Limits on Interest Rate Changes

The interest rate at the first Change Date will not be greater than 12.950 % or less than 11.950 %. Thereafter, the adjustable interest rate will never be increased or decreased on any single Change Date by more than percentage points (\Re) from the rate of interest applicable during the preceding 1.000 6 months. The adjustable interest rate will never be greater than 17.950 %, which is called the "Maximum Rate" or less than 11.950 %, which is called the "Minimum Rate".

(e) Effective Date of Changes

Each new adjustable interest rate will become effective on each Change Date. The amount of each new monthly payment will be due and payable on the first monthly payment date after the Change Date until the amount of the monthly payment changes again.

(f) Notice of Changes

The Lender will deliver or mail a notice of any changes in the adjustable interest rate and the amount of the new monthly payment to the Borrower before the effective date of any change. The notice will include information required by law to be given to the Borrower and also the title and telephone number of a person who will answer any questions regarding the notice.

B. TRANSFER OF THE PROPERTY OR A BENEFICIAL INTEREST IN BORROWER

1. Until Borrower's initial fixed interest rate changes to an adjustable interest rate under the terms stated in Section A above, Uniform Covenant 17 of the Security Instrument provides as follows:

Transfer of the Property or a Beneficial Interest in Borrower. If all or any part of the Property or any interest in it is sold or transferred (or if a beneficial interest in Borrower is sold or transferred and Borrower is not a natural person) without Lender's prior written consent, Lender may, at its option, require immediate payment in full of all sums secured by this Security Instrument. However, this option shall not be exercised by Lender if exercise is prohibited by federal law as of the date of this Security Instrument.

If Lender exercises this option, Lender shall give Borrower notice of acceleration. The notice shall provide a period of not less than 30 days from the date the notice is delivered or mailed within which Borrower must pay all sums secured by this Security Instrument. If Borrower fails to pay these sums prior

to the expiration of this period, Lender may invoke any remedies permitted by this Security Instrument without further notice or demand on Borrower.

2. When Borrower's initial fixed interest rate changes to an adjustable interest rate under the terms stated in Section A above, Uniform Covenant 17 of the Security Instrument contained in Section B(1) above shall then cease to be in effect, and Uniform Covenant 17 of the Security Instrument shall be amended to read as follows:

Transfer of the Property or a Beneficial Interest in Borrower. If all or any part of the Property or any interest in it is sold or transferred (or if a beneficial interest in Borrower is sold or transferred and Borrower is not a natural person) without Lender's prior written consent, Lender may, at its option, require immediate payment in full of all sums secured by this Security Instrument. However, this option shall not be exercised by Lender if exercise is prohibited by federal law as of the date of this Security Instrument. Lender also shall not exercise this option if: (a) Borrower causes to be submitted to Lender information required by Lender to evaluate the intended transferee as if a new loan were being made to the transferee; and (b) Lender reasonably determines that Lender's security will not be impaired by the loan assumption and that the risk of a breach of any covenant or agreement in this Security Instrument is acceptable to Lender.

To the extent permitted by applicable law, Lender may charge a reasonable fee as a condition to Lender's consent to the loan assumption. Lender also may require the transferree to sign an assumption agreement that is acceptable to Lender and that obligates the transferree to keep all the promises and agreements made in the Note and in this Security Instrument. Borrower will continue to be obligated under the Note and Security Instrument unless Lender releases Borrower in writing.

If Lender exercises the option to require immediate payment in full, Lender shall give Borrower notice of acceleration. The notice shall provide a period of not less than 30 days from the date the notice is delivered or mailed within which Borrower must pay all sums secured by this Security Instrument. If Borrower fails to pay these sums prior to the expiration of this period. Lender may invoke any remedies permitted by this Security Instrument without further notice or demand on Borrower.

BY SIGNING BELOW, Borrower accepts and agrees to the terms and covenants contained in this Fixed/Adjustable Rate Rider.
