Therefore be it resolved by this Board of County Commissioners that the County Engineer is hereby ordered to examine the matter and report his findings together with a map of survey.

Whereas this Board has by resolution number 423 stated the intent to vacate a certain county road designated as portion of a county road known as "The Old Wind River Road" more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point 174.91 feet North and 395.53 feet East of the S.E. Corner of the N.W. 1/4 of the S.E. 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4 of Section 15, Township 4 North, Range 7 E.W.M. according to County Engineer's survey as recorded in file drawer G, folder 3, Sheet 8A; thence N 70° 21' W 510 feet; thence N 51° 41' W 660.33 feet; thence N 29° 15' W 157.3 feet; thence N 46° 34' W 202.6; thence N 71° 33' W 341.75 feet to the easterly right of way of the Little Soda Springs Road.

And whereas the County Engineer has reported recommending such vacation.

Now therefore be it resolved that this Board will hold a public hearing on the proposed vacation in the County Commissioners Room in the Shamania County Court House in Stevenson, Washington at 10:00 A.M. Dec 17, 1966.

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Stevenson, Washington, Dec. 6, 1965 (Con't)

Resolution No. 424 - "Intent to Vacate Abandoned County Road at Stabler" was adopted upon the recommendation of County Engineer Clark H. Eldridge. 69

Resolution No. 421 - "Intent to Vacate County Road, a Portion of the Old Cook- Underwood Road and County Pit at Underwood Hill" was passed by unanimous vote and, by Resolution No. 422, a public hearing on the proposed vacation was set for December 20th, 1965. 78

Robert Dubois and Steve Smith, representing Wauna Lake Club, appeared regarding trespass on Wauna property. A hearing date of January 10th, 1966, was established to review figures of the amount of gravel and rock removed by the County. Co. Engineer Clark Eldridge was to compile these figures to determine actual yardage from measurement or cross-section.

The one motion made and seconded, tax levies as presented for 1966 were adopted. 86

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting adjourned at 12:00 noon.

Stevenson, Washington, Dec. 20, 1965


The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on December 20th, 1965, at 10:00 A.M. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Lyle W. Ternahan and all members of the Board were in attendance.

Mrs. Orale Reude and Mrs. Davis appeared in behalf of Cape-Horn Skye School District #15 to discuss possible consolidation or annexation with Washougal. Assessor John Allinger explained what it would mean in the event we lost a portion of the assessed valuation. Attorney R. J. Salvenson was asked and gave legal answers to many aspects of the school problem. Mrs. Reude and Mrs. Davis suggested a joint meeting of the Board of County Commissioners and the County School Board.

Resolution No. 426 - "To Perform Certain Road Repair and Clearing in the General Area of Kanaka Creek by Day Labor" was approved by unanimous vote; estimated cost to be \$1,200.00. 69

Bids were open at 11:00 A.M. as specified on the 1966 bid call for petroleum products. County Engineer Eldridge opened and read the bids, tabulated the results thereof, and it was found to be that the Shell Oil Company was low bidder of regular gasoline at .2115 per gallon; the Richfield Oil Company was low bidder of Ethel gasoline at .2347 per gallon; and the Union Oil Company was low bidder on diesel, both heating and automotive, at .1117 per gallon. All companies bidding on asphalt were identical and it was therefore decided that awards would be made to the above stated low bidders, but that no award would be made on asphalt.

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned.




Stevenson, Washington, Jan. 3, 1966
