The term "Indebtedness" as used in this Deed of Trust, shall mean the debt to Credit Union described above, including interest thereon as described in the credit agreement, plus (a) any amounts expended or advanced by Credit Union to discharge Grantor's obligations hereunder, and (b) any expenses incurred by Credit Union or Trustee to enforce Grantor's obligations hereunder, with interest thereon at the rate of Agreement. The credit agreement describing the repayment terms of the Indebtedness, and any notes, agreements, or documents given to renew, extend or substitute for the credit agreement originally issued is referred to as "the Agreement". The rate of interest on the Agreement is subject to indexing, adjustment, renewal, or renegotiation.

The term "Borrower" is used in the Deed of Trust for the convenience of the parties, and use of that term shall not affect the liability of any such Borrower on the Agreement or create any legal or equitable interest in the Property in Borrower by reason of this Deed of Trust.   1. Rights and Obligations of Borrower. Borrower Grantor has various rights and obligations under this Deed of Trust. These rights and responsibilities are set forth in the following paragraphs: 1.1. Payments and Performance. 2. Possession and Maintenance of Property. 3. Taxes and Liens; 4. Property Damage Insurance, 5. Expenditure by Credit Union, 7. Condemnation, 8.2. Remedies, 10.1. Consent by Credit Union, 10.2. Effect of Consent, 11. Security Agreement, Financing Statements: 14. Actions Upon Termination, 14.5. Attorneys Fees and Expenses: 16.2. Unit Ownership Power of Altorney: 16.3. Annual Reports: 16.5. Joint and Several Liability; 16.8. Waiver of Homostead Exemption, and 17.3. No Modifications.

  1.1. Payment and Performance. Grantor shall pay to Credit Union all amounts secured by this Deed of Trust as they become due, and shall strictly perform all of Grantor's obligations.
- - 2. Possession and Maintenance of the Property.
- Possession. Until in default, Grantor may remain in possession and control of and operate and manage the Property and collect the Income from the Property.
- 2.2 Duty to Maintain. Grantor shall maintain the Property in first class condition and promptly perform all repairs and maintenance necessary to present its value.
- 2.3 Nuisance, Waste. Grantor shall neither conduct or permit any nuisance nor commit or suffer any strp or waste on or to the Property or portion thereof including without limitation removal or alienation by Grantor of the right to remove any timber, minerals (including oil and gas), or well or rock products.
- 2.4 Removal of Improvements. Grantor shall not demolish or remove any improvements from the Real Property without the prior written consent of Credit Union. Credit Union shall consent if Grantor makes arrangements satisfactory to Credit Union to replace any improvement which Grantor proposes to remove with one of at least equal value. "Improvements" shall include all existing and future buildings, structures, and parking facilities.

  2.5 Credit Union's Right to Enter. Credit Union, its agents and representatives, may enter upon the Property at all reasonable times to attend to Credit Union's interest and to inspect the Property.
- 2.6 Compliance with Governmental Requirements. Grantor shall promptly comply with all taws, ordinances, and regulations of all governmental authorities applicable to the use or occupancy of the Property. Grantor may contest in good faith any such law, ordinance, or regulation and withhold compliance during any proceeding, including appropriate appeals, so long as Grantor has notified Credit Union in writing prior to doing so and Credit Union's interest in the Property is not jeopardized.

  2.7 Duty of Protect. Grantor may do all other acts, allowed by law, that from the character and use of the Property are reasonably necessary to protect and preserve the security.
- 2.8 Construction Loan. If some or all of the proceeds of the loan creating the Indebtedness are to be used to construct or complete construction y improvement on the Property, the Improvement shall be completed within six months from the date of this Deed of Trust and Grantor shall pay all costs and expenses in connection with the work.
- 2.9 Hazardous Substances. Granfor represents and warrants that the Property has not been and will not be, during the period this deed remains a fien on the Property, used for the creation, manufacture, treatment, storage, or disposal of any hazardous substance, as defined in the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980, and other applicable lederal and state laws or regulations and amendments. Granfor authorizes Credit Union and its agents to enter upon the Property to make such inspections and tests as Credit Union may deem appropriate to determine compliance of the Property with this paragraph. Credit Union's inspections and tests shall be for Credit Union's purposes only and shall not be for the benefit or create any duty or liability to Granfor or any third party. Granfor agrees to indemnify and hold Credit Union harmless against any and all claims and losses including attorney fees resulting from a breach of this paragraph, which shall survive the payment of the indebtedness and satisfaction of this Deed of Trust.

- 3.1 Payment. Grantor shall pay when due before they become delinquent all taxes and assessments levied against or on account of the Property, and shall pay when due all claims for work done or or for services rendered or material furnished to the Property. Grantor shall maintain the Property free of any liens having priority over or equal to the interest of Credit Union under this Deed of Trust, except for the fine of taxes and assessments not due, except for the prior indebtedness referred to in Section 17, and except as otherwise provided in Subsection 3.2.

  3.2 Right to Contest. Grantor may withhold payment of any tax, assessment, or claim in connection with a good faith dispute over the obligation to pay, so long as Credit Union's interest in the Property is not jeopardized. If a lien arises or is filled as a result of nonpayment, Grantor shall within 15 days after the lien arises or, if a lien is filled, within 15 days after Grantor has notice of the filling, secure the discharge of the lien or deposit with Credit Union, cash or a sufficient corporate surely bond or other security satisfactory to Credit Union in an amount sufficient to discharge the lien plus any costs, altomeys fees, or other charges that could accrue as a result of a foreclosure or sale under the lien.

  3.3 Evidence of Payment. Grantor shall upon demand furnish to Credit Union evidence of payment of the taxes or assessments and shall authorize the appropriate county official to deliver to Credit Union at any time a written statement of the taxes and assessments against the Property.

  3.4 Notice of Construction. Grantor shall notify Credit Union at least 15 days before any work is commenced, any services are furnished, or any materials are supplied to the Property if a construction file to could be asserted on account of the work, services, or materials, and the ost exceeds \$5.000 (if the Property is used for nonresidential or commercial purposes) or Stood (if the Property is used as a residence). Grantor will on request furnish to Credit
- furnish to Credit Union advance assurances satisfactory to Credit Union that Grantor can and will pay the cost of such improvements.

  3.5 Tax Reserves. Subject to any limitations set by applicable law, Credit Union may require Borrower to maintain with Credit Union reserves for payment of taxes and assessments, which reserves shall be created by advance payment or monthly payments of a sum estimated by Credit Union to be sufficient to produce, at least 15 days before due, amounts at least equal to the taxes and assessments to be paid. If 15 days before payment is due the reserve funds are insufficient. Borrower shall upon demand pay any deficiency to Credit Union. The reserve funds shall be held by Credit Union a general deposit from Borrower and shall unless otherwise required by law, constitute a non-interest bearing debt from Credit Union to Borrower, which Credit Union may satisfy by payment of the taxes and assessments required to be paid by Borrower as they become due. Credit Union does not hold the reserve funds in trust for Borrower, and Credit Union is not the agent of Borrower for payment of the taxes and assessments required to be paid by Borrower.
  - 4. Property Damage Insurance.
- 4.1 Maintenance of Insurance. Grantor shall produce and maintain polities of fire insurance with standard all-risk extended coverage endorsements on a replacement basis for the full insurable value basis covering all improvements on the Real Property in an amount sufficient to avoid application of any coinsurance clause, and with a imortgagee's loss payable clause in favor of Credit Union. Policies shall be written by surface companies and in such form as may be reasonably acceptable to Credit Union. Grantor shall deliver to Credit Union certificates of coverage from each insurer containing a stipulation that coverage will not be cancelled or diminished without a minimum of 10 days written notice to Credit Union.
- 4.2 Application of Proceeds, Gration shall promptly notify Credit Union of any loss or damage to the Property. Credit Union may make proof of ioss if Grantor falls to do so within 15 days of the casualty. Credit Union of any loss or damage to the Property. 14. Actions Upon Termination.

14.1 Remedies. Upon the occurrence of any termination and at any time thereafter, Trustee or Credit Union may exercise any one or more of the lotowing rights and remedies, in addition to any other rights or remedies provided by law.
