The Grantor, Linda L. Peters, for and in consideration of a Boundary Line Adjustment, conveys and quit claims to the Grantee, Lester Burns Family Limited Partnership, and Burns & Burns Timber Management Inc., the following described real estate.

Lot 2, Burns & Burns Short Plat

A portion of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 29, Township 2 North, Range 5 East of the Willamette Meridian in Skamania County, Washington as follows:

BEGINNING at the northeast corner of said Southeast Quarter of said Northeast Quarter; thence South along the section line 528 feet more or less; thence West 472 feet more or less to the true point of beginning; thence West 330 feet along the North side of Lot 1; thence South 264 feet along the West side of Lot 1; thence West 90 feet; thence North 465 feet; thence East 465 feet; thence South 465 feet; thence west 45 feet; thence North 264 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.

TOGETHER WITH a thirty foot non-exclusive easement through Grantees' property located in the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter and the North half of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter, Section 29, Township 2 North, Range 5 East of the Willamette Meridian, commencing at the Southwest corner of the above described parcel and connecting with the county road known as North Fork Road on the West side of Grantees' property.

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This deed constitutes a boundary line adjustment between the adjoining property of the Grantor and Grantee herein: it is not intended to create a separate parcel and is therefore exempt from the requirements of RCW 58.17 and the Skamania County Short Plat Ordinance. The herein described property cannot be segregated and sold without first conforming to the State of Washington and Skamania County Subdivision laws.

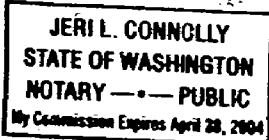
