TRAVERSE STATEMENT: A closed field traverse for the parcel shown was made with a Sokkia five-second total station and related measuring equipment, all of which met State standards of WAC 332-130 at the time of this survey. Acceptable raw angular and distance closures in excess of 1:10000 were balanced by compass adjustment to effect mathematical closure. Physical appurtenances which may be in conflict with existing conditions or items of record are noted as shown. Field work was conducted during the period of April 23 - June 18, 2001.

SURVEY NARRATIVE: The iron pipe found near the northeast corner of this parcel would appear to have been used for the location of the structures and trees near this line, most appearing to be approximately 75 years old. See Note 2.

Found 1" iron pipe, N 25°37'58" W, 4.58 feet from calculated line, possibly set as POL of Lot 9 of Ref. 5, not accepted as being on the Division Line of Shepard D.L.C.

Note 2:

North line from found 1" iron pipe bears N89°59'01"W, 298.48 ft. to set monument. There are no encroachments on this line.
