  1. Payment of Principal and Interest; Prepayment and Late Charges. Borrower shall prompt pay when due the principal of and interest on the debt evidenced by the Note and any prepayment and in arges. Borrower shall promptly charges due under the Note.
- 2. Funds for Taxes and Insurance. Borrower shall promptly furnish to Lender stall promptly fu

The insurance carrier providing the insurance shall be chosen by Borrower subject to Lender's approval which shall not be unreasonably withheld.
