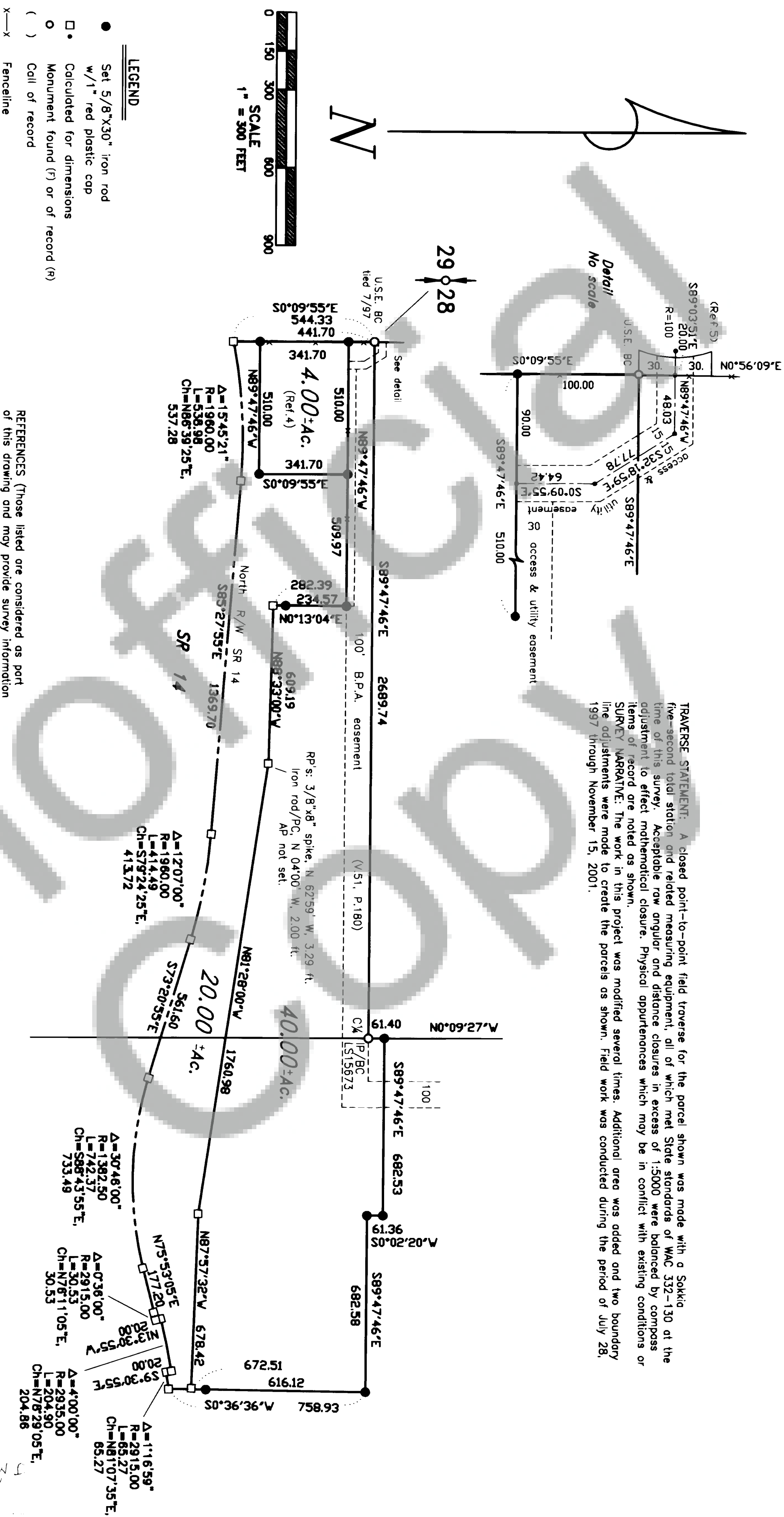


SURVEY in N $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ & SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec.28, T.3 N., R.8 E., W.M.

TRAVERSE STATEMENT: A closed point-to-point field traverse for the parcel shown was made with a Sokkia five-second total station and related measuring equipment, all of which met State standards of WAC 332-130 at the time of this survey. Acceptable raw angular and distance closures in excess of 1:5000 were balanced by compass adjustment to effect mathematical closure. Physical appearances which may be in conflict with existing conditions or items of record are noted as shown.

SURVEY NARRATIVE: The work in this project was modified several times. Additional area was added and two boundary line adjustments were made to create the parcels as shown. Field work was conducted during the period of July 28, 1997 through November 15, 2001.

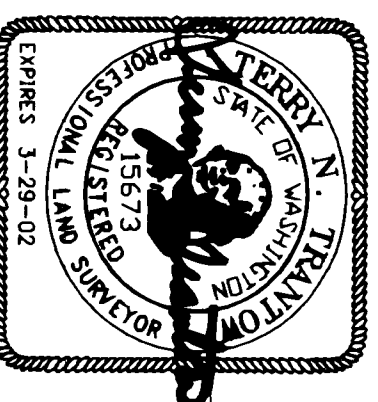
