## PETITION FOR DECLARATORY JUDGMENT

Comes Now the Plaintiff, Joseph Alan Bacus, pro se, and of an for his Motion for Declaratory Judgment states as follows:

- That the Plaintiff is the owner of Lot 3 of the Patricia Andersen Short Plat located in Skamania County, Washington.
- That the Defendants Stanley and Katherine Andersen are the owner's of all other lots in the Patricia Anderson Short Plat.
- 3. That the Defendant Skamania County is a municipal corporation established pursuant to the laws of the State of Washington.
- 4. That in 1894 a portion of the property now know as the Patricia Andersen Short Plat was subdivided into 17 lots 100 feet deep and 50 feet wide and one lot 150 feet wide and 100 feet deep. This subdivision was recorded as the Plat of Sprague Landing and no lots have ever been developed pursuant to the Plat of Sprague Landing.
- 5. That on December 18, 2000, the Skamania County board of Commissioners passed into law Ordinance No. 2000-11 which would permit the lots created by the aforementioned Plat of Sprague Landing or a combination of lots created by the aforementioned Plat of Sprague

Landing, through lot line adjustments, to be utilized as building lots as an exception to current zoning, subdivision and short plat ordinances.

- 6. That Ordinance No. 2000-11 violates state statutes and the state constitution.
- 7. That Ordinance No. 2000-11 is null and void and of no legal force or effect.

Wherefore, Plaintiff respectfully requests that this Honorable Court enter an Order finding that Ordinance No. 2000-11 is unconstitutional and of no legal force or effect and that the property known as the Patricia Andersen Short Plat can not be developed pursuant to this Ordinance and that Plaintiff be awarded attorney fees and costs of suit.
