The credit agreement describing the repayment terms of the indebtedness, and any notes, agreements or documents given to renew, extend or substitute for the credit agreement originally issued is referred to as "the Agreement." The rate of interest on the Agreement is subject to indexing adjustment, renewal, or renegotiation.

The term "Borrower" is used in the Deed of Trust for the convenience of the parties, and use of that term shall not affect the hability of any such Borrower on the Agreement or create any legal or equitable interest in the Property in Borrower by reason of this Deed of Trust. Any Borrower who cosigns this Deed of Trust, but does not execute the Agreement (a) is cosigning this Deed of Trust only to grant and convey that Borrower's interest in the Property to Trustee under the terms of this Deed of Trust, (b) is not personally liable under the Agreement except as otherwise provided by fawling or contract, and (c) agrees that Credit Union and any other borrower hereunder may agree to extend, modify, forebear, release any coflateral, or make any other accommodations or amendments with regard to the terms of this Deed of Trust or the Agreement, without notice to that Borrower, without that Borrower's consent and without releasing that Borrower or modifying this Deed of Trust as to that Borrower's interest in the Property.

This Deed of Trust including the security interest is given to secure payment of the Indebtedness and performance of all Granton's obligations under this Deed of Trust and the Agreement and is given and accepted under the following terms:

- 1. Rigits and Obligations of Borrower. Borrower Grantor has various rights and obligations under this Deed of Trust. These rights and responsibilities are set forth in the following paragraphs: 1. Payments and Performance, 2. Possession and Maintenance of Proporty; 3. Taxes and Liens; 4. Property Damage Insurance, 5. Expenditure by Credit Union, 7. Condemnation, 8.2. Remedies; 10.1. Consent by Credit Union; 10.2 Effect of Consent; 11. Security Agreement, Financing Statements; 14. Actions Upon Termination, 14.5. Attorneys Fees and Expenses; 16.2. Unit Ownership Power of Attorney, 16.3. Annual Reports; 16.5. Joint and Several Liability, 16.8. Waiver of Homestead Exempton, and 17.3. No Modifications.
- 1.1 Payment and Performance. Grantor shall pay to Credit Union all amounts secured by this Deed of Trust as they become due, and shall strictly perform all of Grantor's obligations
 - 2. Possession and Maintenance of the Property.
- 2.1 Possession. Until in default, Grantor may remain in possession and control of and operate and manage the Property and collect the income from the Property.
- 2.2 Outy to Maintain. Grantor shall maintain the Property in first class condition and promptly perform all repairs and maintenance necessary to preserve its value.
- 2.3 Nulsance, Waste. Grantor shall neither conduct or permit any nuisance nor commit or suffer any strip or waste on or to the Property or any portion thereof including without limitation removal or alienation by Grantor of the right to remove any timber, minerals (including oil and gas), or gravel or rock products.
- 2.4 Removal of Improvements. Grantor shall not demolish or remove any improvements from the Real Property without the prior written consent of Credit Union. Credit Union shall consent if Grantor makes arrangements satisfactory to Credit Union to replace any improvement which Grantor proposes to remove with one of at least equal value. "Improvements" shall include all existing and future buildings, structures, and parking facilities.
- 2.5 Credit Union's Right to Enter. Credit Union, its agents and representatives, may enter upon the Property at all reasonable times to attend to Credit Union's interest and to inspect the Property.
- 2.6 Compliance with Governmental Requirements. Grantor shall promptly comply with all laws, ordinances, and regulations of all governmental authorities applicable to the use or occupancy of the Property Grantor may contest in good faith any such law, ordinance, or regulation and withhold compliance during any proceeding, including appropriate appeals, so long as Grantor has notified Credit Union in writing prior to doing so and Credit Union's interest in the Property is not jeopardized.
- 2.7 Outy of Protect. Grantor may do all other acts, allowed by law, that from the character and use of the Property are reasonably necessary to protect and preserve the security.
- 2.8 Construction Loan. If some or all of the proceeds of the loan creating the indobtedness are to be used to construct or complete construction of any improvement on the Property, the Improvement shall be completed within six months from the date of this Deed of Trust and Grantor shall pay in full all costs and expenses in connection with the work.

 2.9 Hazardous Substances. Grantor represents and warrants that the Property has not been and will not be, during the period this deed remains a tien on the Property, used for the creation, manufacture, treatment, storage, or disposal of any hazardous substance, as defined in the Comprehensive Environmental Response. Credit Union's inspections and tests shall be for Credit Union harmless against any and all claims and losses including afterney fees resulting from a breach of this paragraph, which shall survive the payment of the indebtedness and satisfaction of this Deed of Trust.

 3. Taxes and Liens.
 - 3. Taxes and Liens.
- 3.1 Payment. Grantor shall pay when due before they become delinquent all taxes and assessments levied against or on account of the Property, and shall pay when due all claims for work done on or for services rendered or material furnished to the Property. Grantor shall maintain the Property free of any liens having priority over or equal to the interest of Credit Union under this Deed of Trust, except for the lien of taxes and assessments not due, except for the prior indebtedness referred to in Section 17, and except as otherwise provided in Subsection 3.2.
- 3.2 Right to Contest. Grantor may withhold payment of any tax, assessment, or claim in connection with a good faith dispute over the obligation to pay so long as Credit Union's interest in the Property is not jeopardized.  3.4 Notice of Construction. Grantor shall notify Credit Union at least 15 days before any work is commenced, any services are furnished, or any materials are supplied to the Property if a construction lien could be asserted on account of the work, services, or materials, and the costs exceeds \$5,000 (if the Property is used for nonresidential or commercial purposes) or \$1,000 (if the Property is used as a residence). Grantor will on request furnish to Credit Union advance assurances satisfactory to Credit Union that Grantor can and will pay the cost of such Improvements.

 3.5 Tax Reserves. Subject to any limitations set by applicable law, Credit Union may require Borrower to maintain with Credit Union reserves or payment of taxes and assessments, which reserves shall be created by advance payment or monthly payments of a sum estimated by Credit Union to be sufficient to produce, at least 15 days before due, amounts at least equal to the taxes and assessments to be paid. If 15 days before payment is due the reserve funds are insufficient, Borrower shall upon demand pay any deficiency to Credit Union. The reserve funds shall be held by Credit Union to general deposit from Borrower and shall, unless otherwise required by law, constitute a non-interest bearing debt from Credit Union to Borrower, which Credit Union may satisfy by payment of the taxes and assessments required to be paid by Borrower as they become due. Credit Union does not hold the reserve funds in trust for Borrower, and Credit Union is not the agent of Borrower for payment of the taxes and assessments required to be paid by Borrower.

 4. Property Damage Insurance.
 - 4. Property Damage Insurance.
- 4.1 Maintenance of Insurance. Grantor shall produce and maintain policies of fire insurance with standard aff-risk extended coverage endorsements on a replacement basis for the full insurable value basis covering all Improvements on the Real Property in an amount sufficient to avoid application of any coinsurance clause, and with a mortgage's loss payable clause in favor of Credit Union. Policies shall be written by such insurance companies and in such form as may be reasonably acceptable to Credit Union. Grantor shall deliver to Credit Union certificates of coverage from each insurer containing a stipulation that coverage will not be cancelled or diminished without a minimum of 10 days' written notice to Credit Union.
- 4.2 Application of Proceeds. Grantor shall promptly notify Credit Union of any loss or damage to the Property. Credit Union may make proof of loss if Grantor fails to do so within 15 days of the casualty. Credit Union may, at its election, apply the proceeds to the reduction of the Indebtedness or the resultance repair of the Property. If Credit Union elects to apply the proceeds to the reduction of the Indebtedness or the resultance and repair of the Property. If Credit Union elects to apply the proceeds to restoration and repair, Grantor shall repair or replace the damaged or destroyed Improvements in a manner satisfactory to Credit Union. Credit Union shall, upon satisfactory proof of such expenditure, pay or reimburse Grantor from the proceeds for the reasonable cost of repair or restoration if Grantor is not in default hereunder. Any proceeds which have not been paid out within 180 days after their receipt and which Credit Union has not committed to the repair or restoration of the Property shall be used to prepay first accrued interest and then principal of the Indebtedness. If Credit Union holds any proceeds after payment in full of the Indebtedness, such proceeds shall be paid to Grantor.
- 4.3 Unexpired Insurance at Sale. Any unexpired insurance shall inure to the benefit of, and pass to, the purchaser of the Property covered by this Deed of Trust at any trustee's or other sale held under the provision contained within, or at any foreclosure sale of such Property.
- 4.4 Compliance with Prior Indebtedness. C. Change in Terms. The Agreement permits Credit Union to make certain changes to the terms of the Agreement at specified times or upon the occurrence of specified events.

14. Actions Upon Termination.

14.1 Remedies. Upon the occurrence of any termination and at any time thereafter, Trustee or Credit Union may exercise any one or more of the following rights and remedies, in addition to any other rights or remedies provided by law:

(a) With respect to all or any part of the Real Property, the Trustee shall have the right to foreclose by judicial foreclosure, in either case in accordance with and to the full extent provided by applicable law.

Credit Union shall have the right to exercise this power, as Credit Union may see fit.

16.3 Annual Reports. If the Property is used for purposes other than grantor's residence, within 60 days following the close of each fiscal year of Grantor, Grantor shall turnish to Credit Union a statement of net operating income received from the Property during Grantor's previous fiscal year in such detail as Credit Union shall require. 'Net operating income" shall mean all cash receipts from the Property less all cash expenditures made in connection with the operation of the Property.

16.4 Applicable Law. The law of the state in which the Property is located shall be applicable for the purpose of construing and determining the validity of this Deed of Trust and Several Liability. If Grantor consists of more than one person or entity, the obligations imposed upon Grantor under this Deed of Trust shall be joint and Several Liability.
