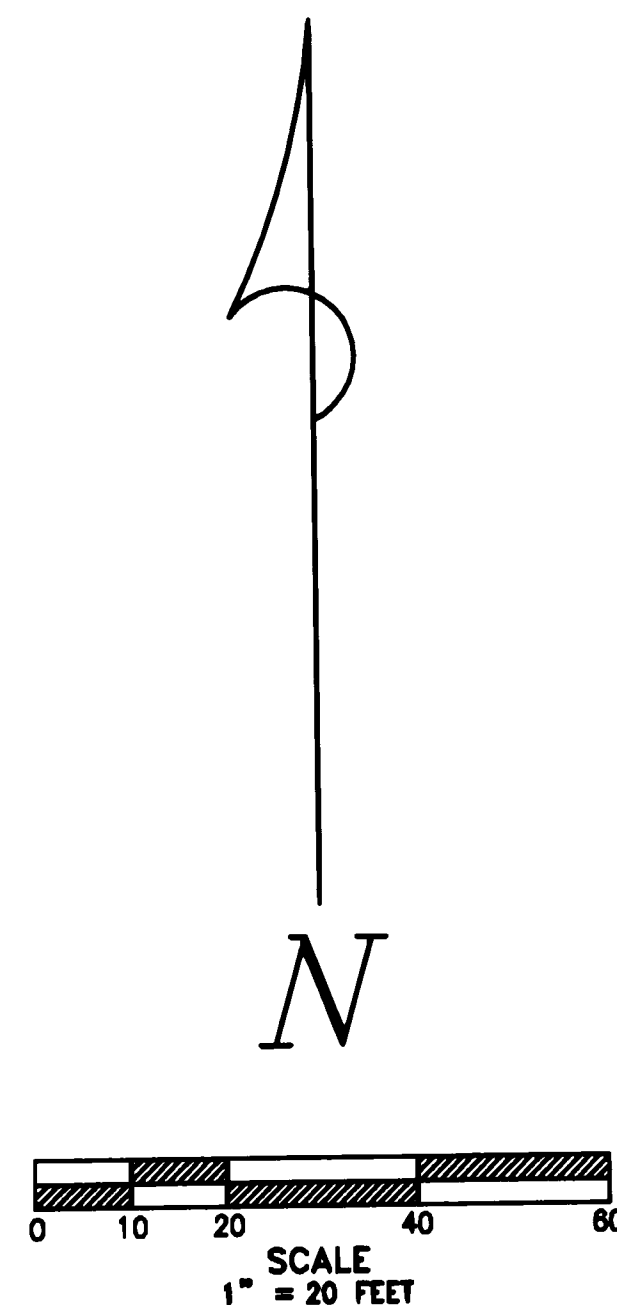

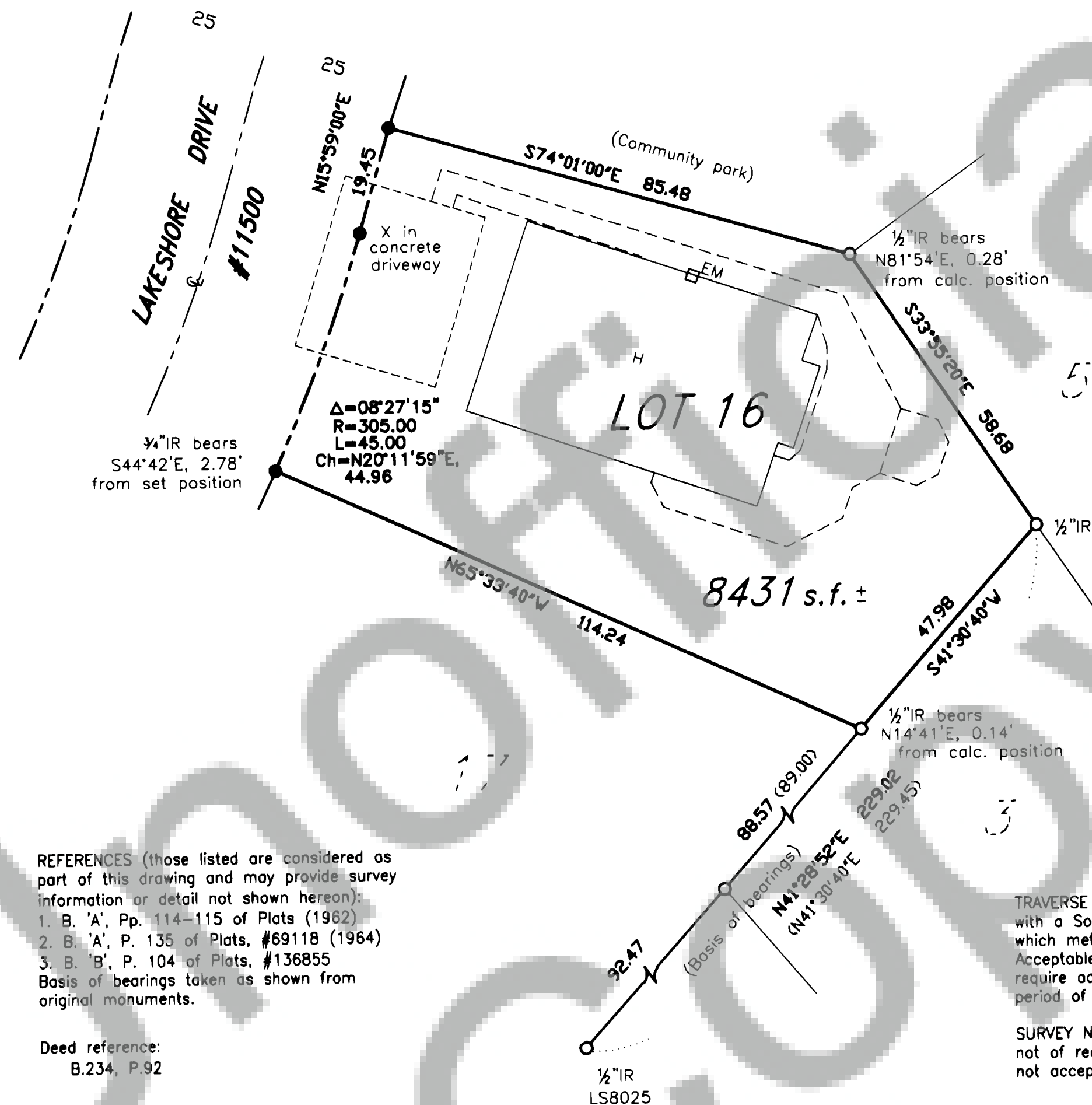

TRAVERSE STATEMENT: A closed field traverse for the parcel shown was made with a Sokkia five-second total station and related measuring equipment, all of which met State standards of WAC 332-130 at the time of this survey. Acceptable raw angular and distance closures in excess of 1:10000 did not require adjustment for mathematical closure. Field work was conducted during the period of January 8-14, 2003.

SURVEY NARRATIVE: Some monuments were likely established more recently but not of record; the monument found at the Southwest corner of the parcel was not accepted.
