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PARTIAL RELEASE OF EASEMENT

PACIFICORP, an Oregon Corporation, the successor company to Northwestern Electric Company, hereby disclaims and releases to the Owners of Record, Gary W. Phillips, as his separate estate, any right, title or interest it may have to that portion of certain easements dated February 17, 1913, recorded on March 20, 1913, in Book O, Page 266, and dated May 21, 1912, recorded on June 4, 1912, in Book N, Page 597, records of Skamania County, Washington, in and to the following described real property and as further described and shown on the attached Exhibit A.

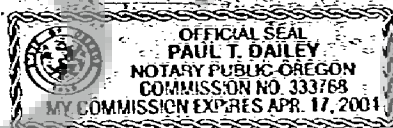

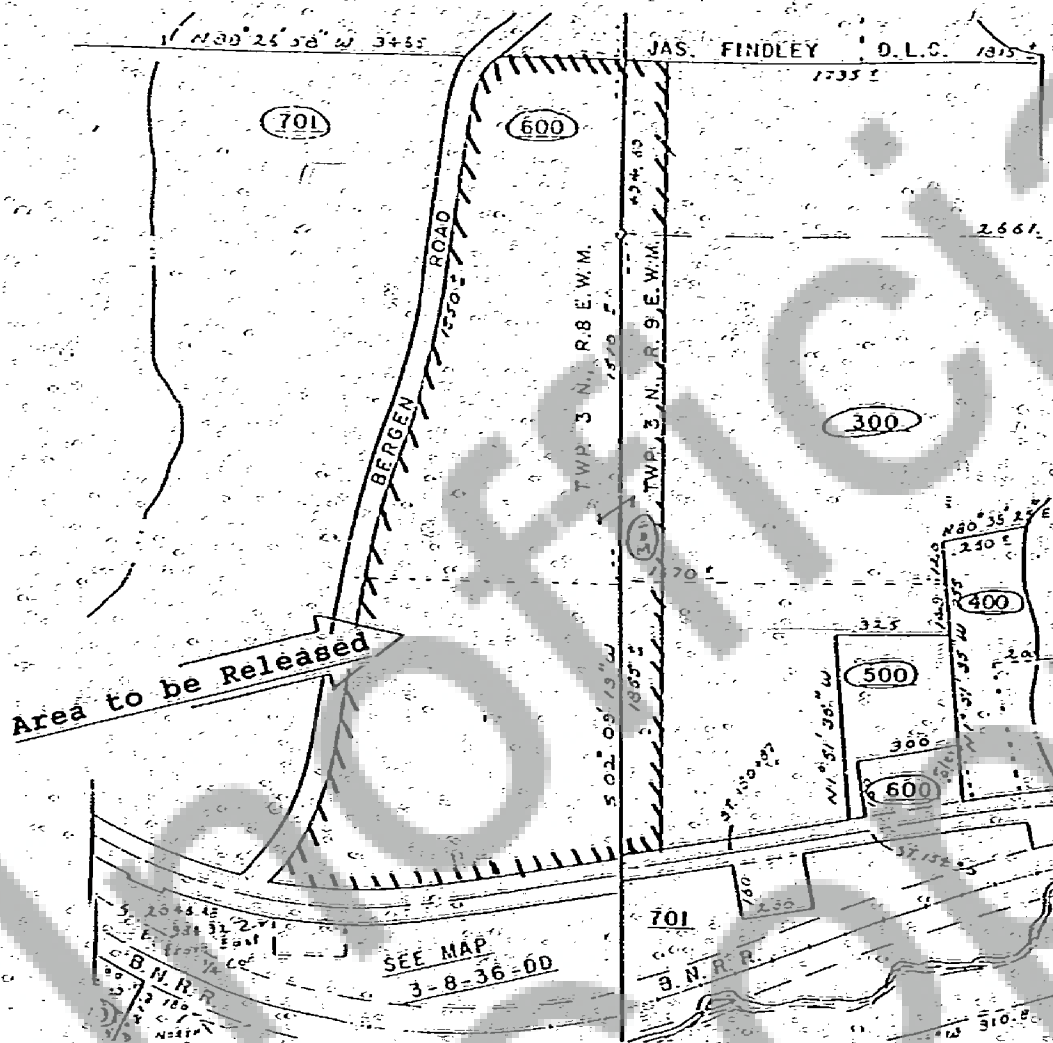
