The term "Indebtedness" as used in this Deed of Trust, shall mean the debt to Credit Union described above, including interest thereon as described in the credit agreement, plus (a) any amounts expended or advanced by Credit Union to discharge Grantor's obligations hereunder, and (b) any expenses incurred by Credit Union or Trustee to enforce Grantor's obligations hereunder, with interest thereon at the rate of Agreement.

The credit agreement describing the repayment terms of the Indebtedness, and any notes, agreements, or document given to renew, extend or substitute for the credit agreement originally issued is referred to as "the Agreement." The rate of interest on the Agreement is subject to indexing, adjustment, renewal, or re-negotiation.

The term "Borrower" is used in the Deed of Trust for the convenience of the parties, and use of that term shall not affect the liability of any such Borrower on the Agreement or create any legal or equitable interest in the Property in Borrower by reason of this Deed of Trust. 1.1. Payment and Performance. Granter shall pay to Credit Union all amounts secured by this Deed of Irust as they become due, and shall sarkely perform all of Granter's obligations
2. Possession and Maintenance of the Property.
2.1. Possession. Until in default, Granter may remain in possession and control of and operate and manage the Property and collect the Ironers from the Property.

2.4 Removal of Improvements. Granter shall not demolish or remove any improvements from the Real Property without the prior written consent of Credit Union. "Improvements" shall include all existing and future buildings, structures, and parking facilities.

2.5 Credit Union's Right to Enter. Credit Union, its agents and representatives, may enter upon the Property at all reasonable times to attend to Credit Union's interest and to increout the Property.

3. Taxes and Lieus.

Credit Union shall have the right, without notice to Grantor, to take possession of the Property and collect the Income including furtherance of this right, Credit Union may require any tenant or other user to make payments of rent or use fees directly to Credit Union. If the Income is collected by Credit Union, then Grantor increasely designates Credit Union as Grantor's attorney in fact to endorse instruments received in payment thereof in the name of Grantor and to negotiate the same and collect the proceeds. Payments by tenants or other users to Credit Union in response to Credit Union's derrand shall satisfy the obligation for which the payments are

made, whether or not any proper grounds for the demand existed. Credit Union may exercise its rights under this subparagraph either in person, by agent, or through a receiver. Tredit Union shall have the right to have a receiver appointed to take possession of any or all of the Property, with the power to protect and presence the Property, to operate the Property preceding forceboure or sale, and to collect the Income from the Property and apply the proceeds, over and above cost of the receivership, against the Indebtedness.
