

TRAVERSE STATEMENT: A closed field traverse for the parcel shown was made with a Sokkia Set total station and related measuring equipment, all of which met State standards of WAC 332-130 at the time of this survey. Acceptable raw angular and distance closures in excess of 1:10000 were balanced by compass adjustment to effect mathematical closure. Physical appurtenances which may be in conflict with existing conditions or items of record are noted or depicted. Ties were made to monuments from References 1, 3 and County control monuments. SURVEY NARRATIVE: The intent of this project was to survey the boundaries of the parcel. Initially, the iron pipe (see Note 1) was rejected, which invalidated that survey. Corrections were made in conjunction with an adjacent survey by Bell Design, including a boundary line adjustment being made along the south line of this parcel. Field work was conducted during the period of July 3-10, 2003.
