

Re: Mechanically Broken-down Motorcycle on Wind River Rd. on 8.9.03

Reason for this Memo

This memo is in regards to my '87 Honda Motorcycle being towed from the Wind River rd. on 8/9/03. The vehicle was not in a hazardous location or impeding traffic. It was however broken down due to gravel on the road causing it to loose its grip on the road during a 180-degree turn past mile marker 23. After lifting up the bike I was able to restart it but found the right handle bar was broken making it impossible to use the throttle to drive it in a safe manner. I then proceeded to ride on the back of a friend's bike back to Carson where I was able to use a phone to call and line up a trailer to pick up the bike. Once back in Fairview, OR I picked up the trailer and proceeded to drive back to pick up the bike. When I returned to where I left the bike I found it missing and could tell that someone had pulled up with a truck and trailer and removed the bike. This was only about 4 hrs since I had left it. I proceeded to Stabler, WA and stopped at the local store to contact the Sheriff's office to report a missing bike, where I was informed that the bike had been towed by the Sheriff's office and where it was towed to. I asked Sheriff Rob why it was towed and He informed me that it looked like someone had had an accident and left the scene. I told Him what had happened and due to the location of the bike I was unable to contact anyone due to the lack of cell service. (I also understand that this took place at about 1:00pm just 30 minutes after we had left the bike and drove to Carson, WA. I have the towing company's receipt showing that they were called out at 1:30pm to retrieve the bike.) When I showed up at Bob's Towing imagine my surprise when I was informed that the towing bill was \$215.61. I of course had no choice but to pay it to get my bike back. On Sunday August 10th I was contacted by the Skamania County Sheriff's office asking me if I was the owner of a '87 Honda motorcycle that was on Wind River rd. I responded that I indeed was and had already picked it up the day before from the towing co. I was also interested in finding out why it was towed. The person that called me said the Sheriff was not in the office at the time but She would have someone contact me as soon as they could. I did not hear back from anyone at all. So I called back one week later on 8/18/03. Where I was informed that the incident would not be filed as an accident due to less than \$750 in damage. And I could file a grievance with the County Auditors office in regards to the towing bill. as I am doing here.

Thanks for your consideration in this matter of the cost of having a bike towed when I made a solid attempt to retrieve the broken down bike as soon as I possibly could.

August 19, 2003

Event Time Line

8/9/03

12:15pm - As I was making the turn around a sharp corner on Wind River Rd. about 1/4 of a mile past mile marker 23 I ran over some loose gravel on the paved road. This caused my Motorcycle to loose its grip on the road and consequently come out from under me and slid into the gravel on the side of the road. I immediately got up and proceeded, unhurt, to stand up the bike.

12:35pm - I proceeded to ride on the back of a friend's bike to Carson, WA and called to reserve a trailer to pick up the mechanically un-drivable bike.

1:30pm - I returned to Fairview, OR

2:15pm - Proceeded to pick up a U-haul motorcycle trailer. (U-Haul was quite busy so it took about an hour.)

4:30pm - I arrived just past mile marker 23 to retrieve the broken down bike. (I found it gone so I took a bunch of digital pictures of the markings the truck and trailer had left in the hopes of being able to give the Sheriff's office something to go off of to try and locate my missing or possible stolen bike. I didn't call at this time because there is no Cell service in the area.)

5:15pm - I arrived at the Stabler, WA general store and called the Skamania Co. Sheriff's Office to report a missing bike. Sheriff Rob informed me that it had been towed by their office and where it was located giving me relief that had not been stolen.

5:45pm - I arrived at Bob's Towing and retrieved my bike.

8/10/03

8:45am - Skamania County Sheriff's office called my home to ask if I was the owner of a '87 Honda and I inform me of the bike had been towed. I asked why it had been towed and they were unsure at the time but would have someone contact me.

8/13/03

7:30am - I meet with a group of professionals at the Days Inn in downtown Portland for breakfast. The table right next to us is a group of Portland Police Motorcycle officers that we have gotten to know over the last year. I told them about what had happened when the bike broke down and asked them what Portland's policy on towing broken down vehicles. They said usually if it isn't a hazard they would give it at least 24hrs or more before towing. I already figured that was the case, which is why I made every attempt to pick up the bike as soon as I could.

8/18/03

2:00pm - I called the Skamania County Sheriff's office and asked if someone could talk to me about why the bike was towed within an hour of it having mechanical difficulties and being un-drivable.

8/19/03

9:00am - I wrote This Letter to ask for the reimbursement of \$214.61 for the towing of my '87 Honda.
