- As per SCC §22.06.050(CX2), this Administrative Decision <u>SHALL BE RECORDED</u> by the applicant in the County deed records and submitted to the Planning Department prior to issuance of a building permit for the approved project. A copy of the first page of the recorded Administrative Decision must be submitted to the Planning Department prior to the commencement of the project.
- 2) All developments shall be consistent with the enclosed site plan, unless modified by the following conditions of approval. If modified, the site plan shall be consistent with the conditions of approval.
- 3) The applicant shall follow guidelines under permit approval from the Washington State Department if Agriculture to Discharge Aquatic Pesticides Associated with the control of Noxious Vegetation.
- 4) The project shall be completed by September 21 or before salmon spawning begins in the shallows of the area.
- 5) The following procedures shall be effected when cultural resources are discovered during construction activities:

a) The applicant shall stop all work in the vicinity of the discovery.

- b) The applicant shall immediately notify the Forest Service, the applicant's cultural resource professional, the county coroner, and appropriate law enforcement agencies.
- c) The Forest Service shall notify the tribal governments if the discovery is determined to be an Indian burial or a cultural resource.
