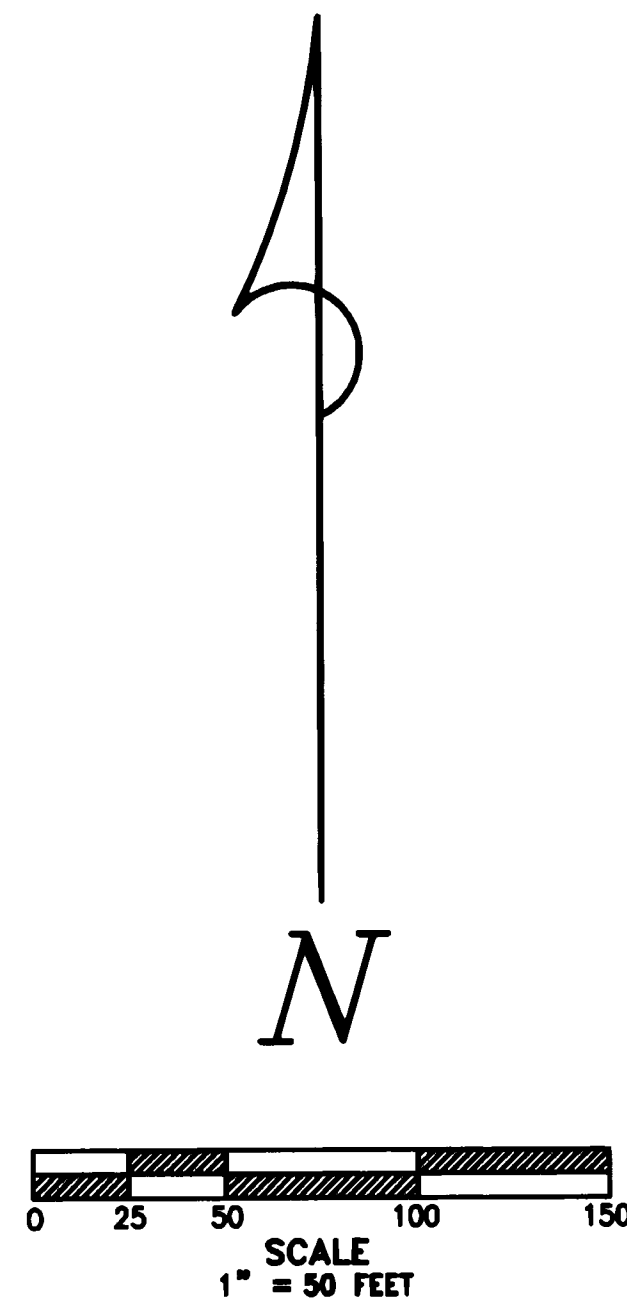

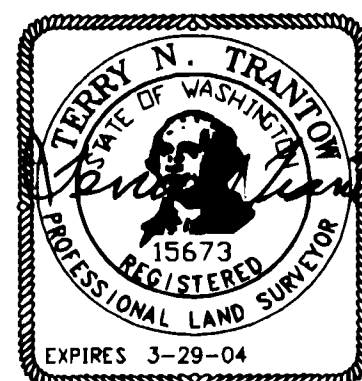

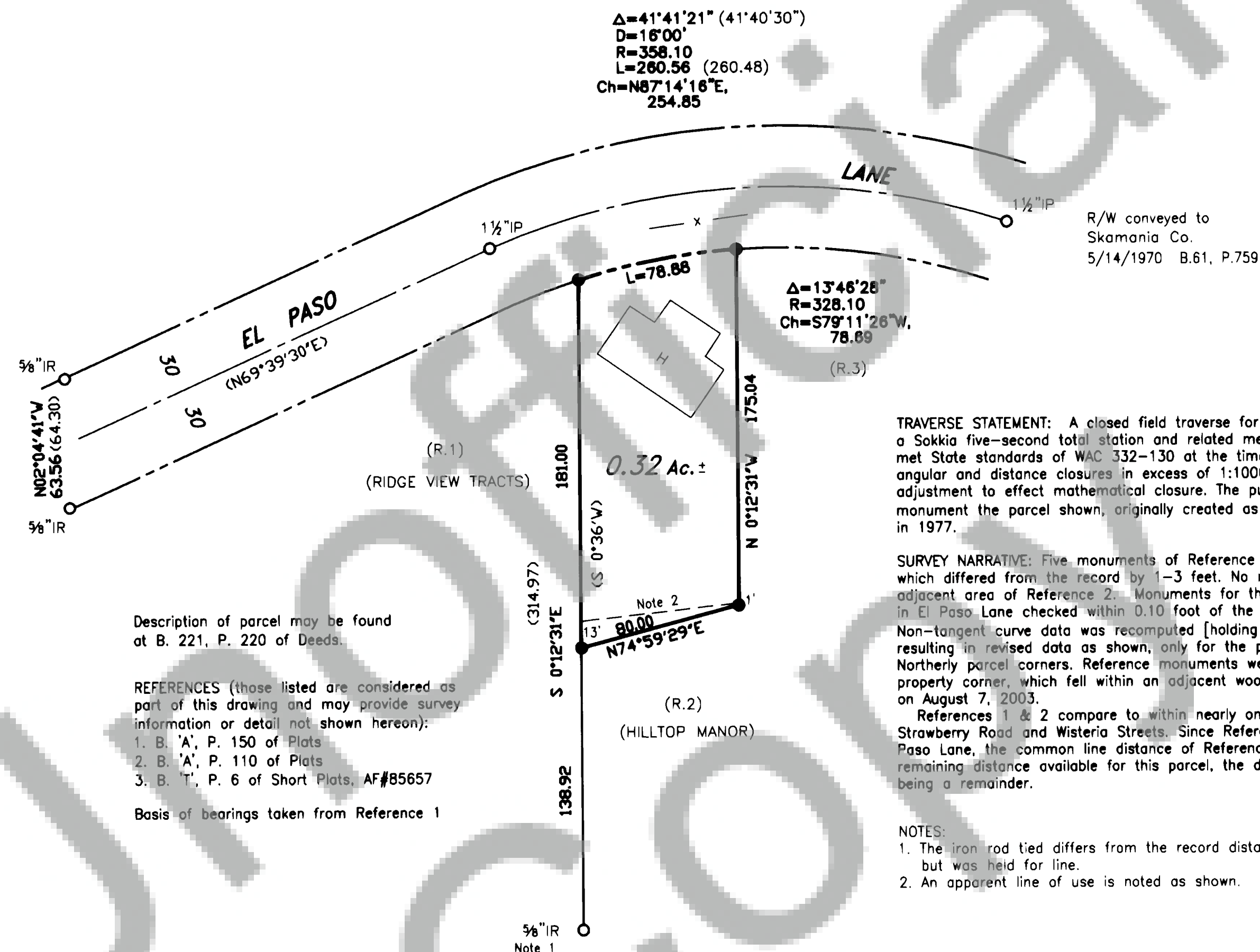

Basis of bearings taken from Reference 1

TRAVERSE STATEMENT: A closed field traverse for the parcel shown was made with a Sokkia five-second total station and related measuring equipment, all of which met State standards of WAC 332-130 at the time of this survey. Acceptable raw angular and distance closures in excess of 1:10000 were balanced by compass adjustment to effect mathematical closure. The purpose of this project was to monument the parcel shown, originally created as Lot 1 of a 'paper' short plat in 1977.

SURVEY NARRATIVE: Five monuments of Reference 1 were found and tied, all of which differed from the record by 1-3 feet. No monuments were found from the adjacent area of Reference 2. Monuments for the PC and PT of the curve shown in El Paso Lane checked within 0.10 foot of the record, but were used as tied. Non-tangent curve data was recomputed [holding 358.10 feet for the radius], resulting in revised data as shown, only for the purpose of determining the Northerly parcel corners. Reference monuments were set on line for the Southwest property corner, which fell within an adjacent woodpile. Field work was completed on August 7, 2003.

References 1 & 2 compare to within nearly one foot in distance between Strawberry Road and Wisteria Streets. Since Reference 1 provides a distance to El Paso Lane, the common line distance of Reference 2 was deducted to find the remaining distance available for this parcel, the description for which treats it as being a remainder.

NOTES:

1. The iron rod tied differs from the record distance but was held for line.
2. An apparent line of use is noted as shown.
