
SURVEY of Lots 1-4, Block 3, Hill Crest Acre Tracts and a portion of Gov't Lot 8, in the SW¼NW¼, all in Section 36, T3N, R7½E, W.M., in the City of Stevenson



TRAVERSE STATEMENT: A closed field traverse for the parcel shown was made with a Sokkia Set -3100 total station and related measuring equipment, all of which met State standards of WAC 332-130 at the time of this survey. Acceptable raw angular and distance closures in excess of 1:10000 were balanced by compass adjustment to effect mathematical closure. Physical appurtenances which may be in conflict with existing conditions or items of record are noted or depicted. The intent of this project was to monument a portion of Government Lot 8 plus those lots within Block 3 of the First Addition to Hill Crest Acre Tracts (Ref. 2).

SURVEY NARRATIVE: Field work was conducted during the period of July 17— September 8, 2003. No monuments in this block were found except for an axle at the south end of the East fence line, which may be from the Plat of Reference 1. The reconstruction of Block 3 used original plat calls as much as possible, but held to Reference 3.
