Petitioner is awarded all rights to Cabin #49 and #15 at Northwoods (legal descriptions attached hereto), all household goods and appliances presently in her possession, her personal effects and belongings, the 1982 Chevrolet Citation subject to Respondent paying encumbrance thereon, and the AMC Hornet automobile also subject to Respondent paying encumbrance thereon. Respondent is awarded all household goods and appliances presently in his possession, his personal effects and belongings and the 1969 Honda Civic automobile.

4. Respondent is required to pay the amount of \$275 on the bill to Copeland Lumber and \$408.50 on the bill to Lewis River Motors. Petitioner is required to pay the balance due after payment by Respondent on the accounts at Copeland Lumber and Lewis River Motors and is further required to pay the debts to Meier & Frank and the Bon Marche.
