Dear Applicant:

The Planning Department issued a second letter amendment to your original Director's Decision on August 11, 1999. That letter amendment, in part, deleted Condition # 15 which was previously added as a condition to the letter amendment issued October 6, 1997. However, since Condition # 15 was deleted due to the fact that you indicated you were going to retain the existing vegetation, a condition should be added stating that you should be required to retain all existing vegetation south of the proposed building sites.

Pursuant to SCC §22.06.080(B), a change or alteration to an approved action, if determined to be minor by the Director, may be "deemed consistent with the provisions of this Title and the findings and conclusions on the original application." I have determined that the proposed request constitutes a minor change,

therefore, the following condition should be added to ensure that vegetation is retained:

15. All existing vegetation south of the proposed development shall be retained and maintained in a healthy condition for screening purposes. Dead or dying trees shall be replaced with the same species of trees in approximately the same location.

As a reminder, your original decision and previous letter amendments along with this letter amendment must be recorded at the County Auditor's office prior to the issuance of any building permits. When recording these documents, you must attach the legal description for your property. This legal description is usually in the form of a deed (i.e. quit claim, warranty, etc.).
