Re: CLAIM FOR LOST WAGES - GRIEVANCE

Dear Bob, Al, and Bud:

Hereby this letter I am advising you that I am pursuing a claim against the county for lost wages from January 2003 to the present. On January 1, 2003, I began serving as the Chief Criminal Deputy in the Skamania County Prosecutor's Office at the appointment/hiring of the elected prosecutor. The entry level salary for this position is classified as a 30A with a pay of \$4382.00. Based upon a decision made by the Board after the 2003 final budget was adopted my salary was set at 28A, \$3998.00. Previously the Board had adopted a salary range of 30 with a pay of \$53,760 pursuant to the final 2003 final budget. There was no reclassification of the position. Furthermore, there was no determination by the elected official that I did not possess the qualifications to perform the functions required of the Chief Criminal Deputy. My salary was kept at this range until July 2003.

In July 2003, my salary was adjusted to 28B pay of \$4309.00 per month. My salary in July 2003 should have been at a range of 30B, \$4712.00 per month. My salary has remained at this level until the present time.

Based upon my rough calculations of the lost wages during this period of time the county owes me \$6737.00 in lost wages, including lost wages for the month of May 2004. This is not taking into consideration lost revenue for social security and unemployment benefits. Furthermore this also does not take into consideration any interest that could have accrued on these lost wages during this period of time. These are all considerations and damages that could be sought in a declaratory judgment.

At this time I am willing to settle this claim against the county for \$6737.00. I look forward to hearing from you regarding my claim against the county for lost wages. It is my desire that this matter can be settled in a timely and reasonable manner.
