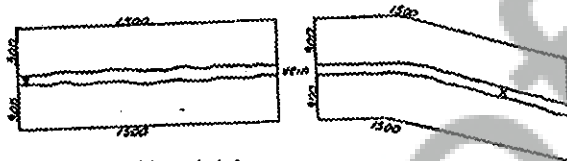

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN That the undersigned who is/are (has/declared \_\_\_\_\_ intention to become) citizen S of the United States, have discovered and have located and claimed and do hereby locate 660' linear feet in length, and 1320' feet in width on the \_\_\_\_\_ Highlands Placer Lode, vein ledge or deposit (or placer ground), situated in the above State, County (or Recording Precinct) and Mining District, and further described as follows: Commencing at a post marked No 1 at the Discovery shaft (cut or tunnel), from thence 660 feet in a S. Westerly direction to an end post marked No 2, thence 660 feet in a North direction to a corner post marked No 3, thence 1320 feet in a East direction to a corner post marked No 4, thence 660 feet in a South direction to a corner post marked No 5, thence \_\_\_\_\_ feet in a \_\_\_\_\_ direction to a corner post marked No 6, thence 660 feet in a N. 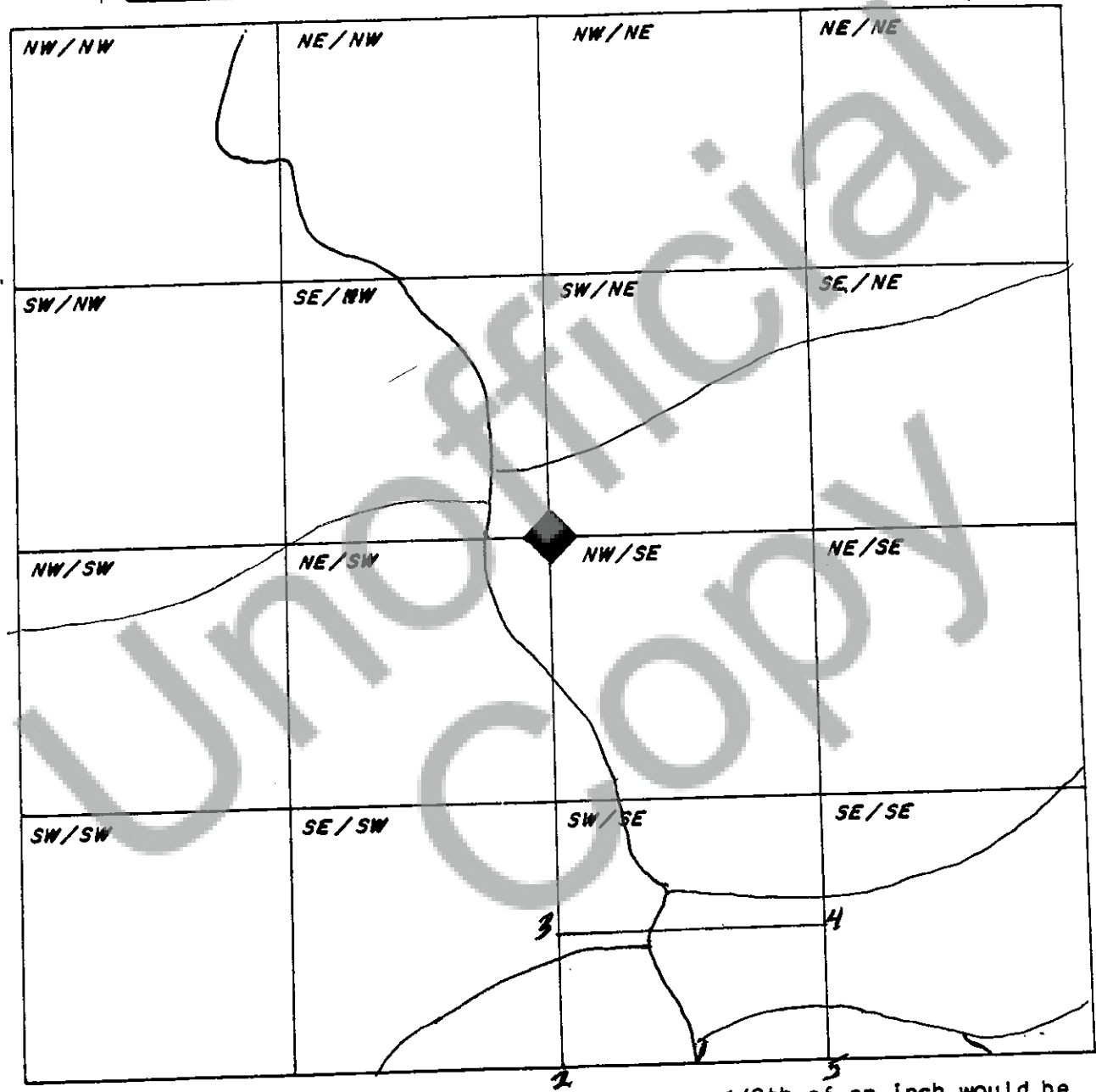
