

TRAVERSE STATEMENT: A point to point field traverse for the parcel shown was made with a Sokkia Set—3100 total station and related measuring equipment, all of which met State standards of WAC 332—130 at the time of this survey. Radial ties to a number of existing monuments were used for control. Physical appurtenances which may be in conflict with existing conditions or items of record are noted or depicted. The intent of this project was to create a two—acre lot around an existing house by a boundary line adjustment.


