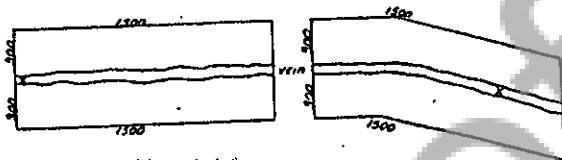

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN That the undersigned who is/are (ha declared intention to become) citizen of the United States, ha discovered and ha located and claimed and do hereby locate 1500 linear feet in length, and 300 feet in width on the Yellow Sack of #2. 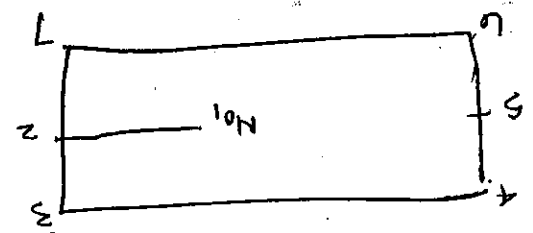

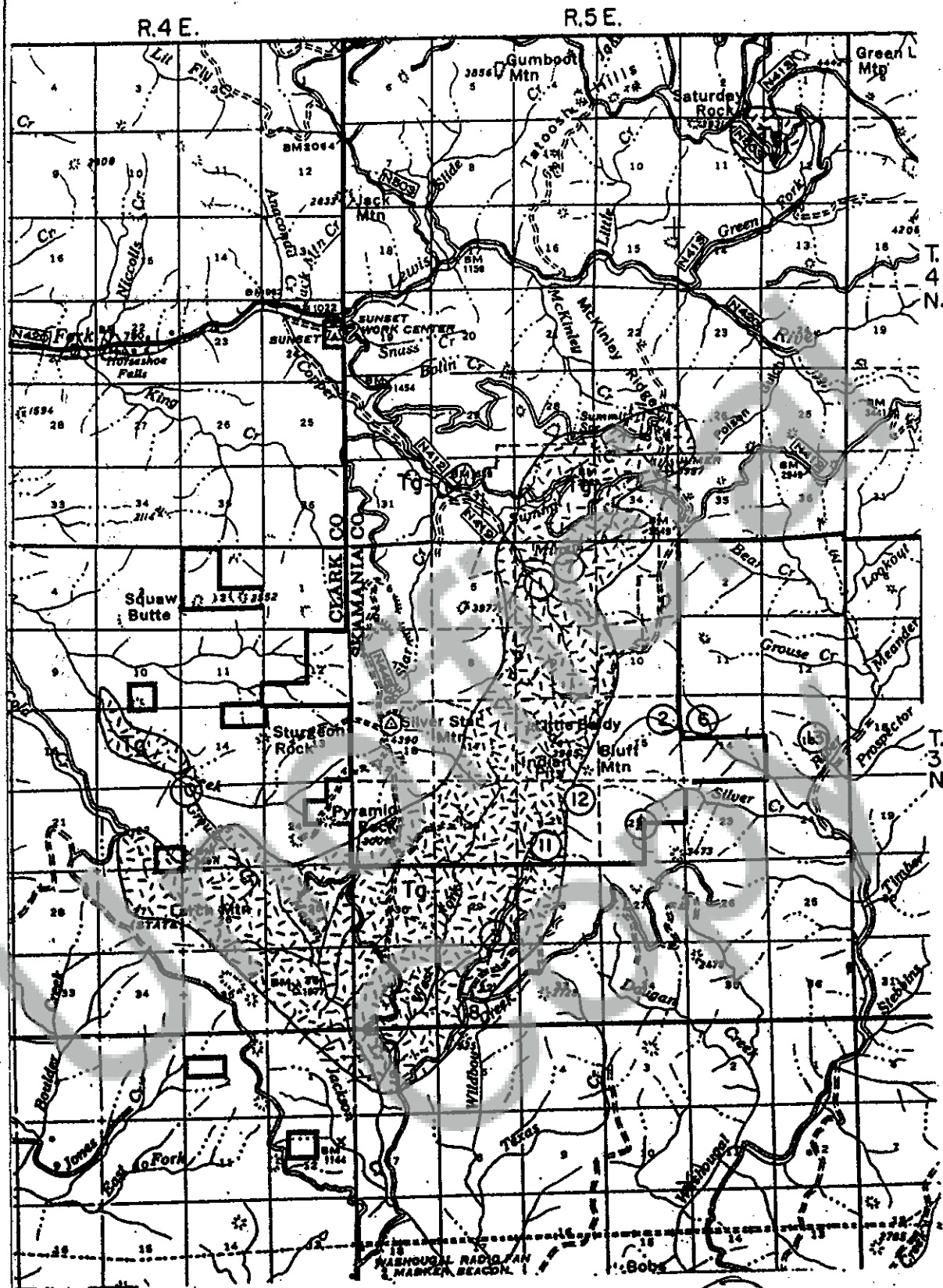

FIGURE 19.—Metal occurrences of the Washougal district.

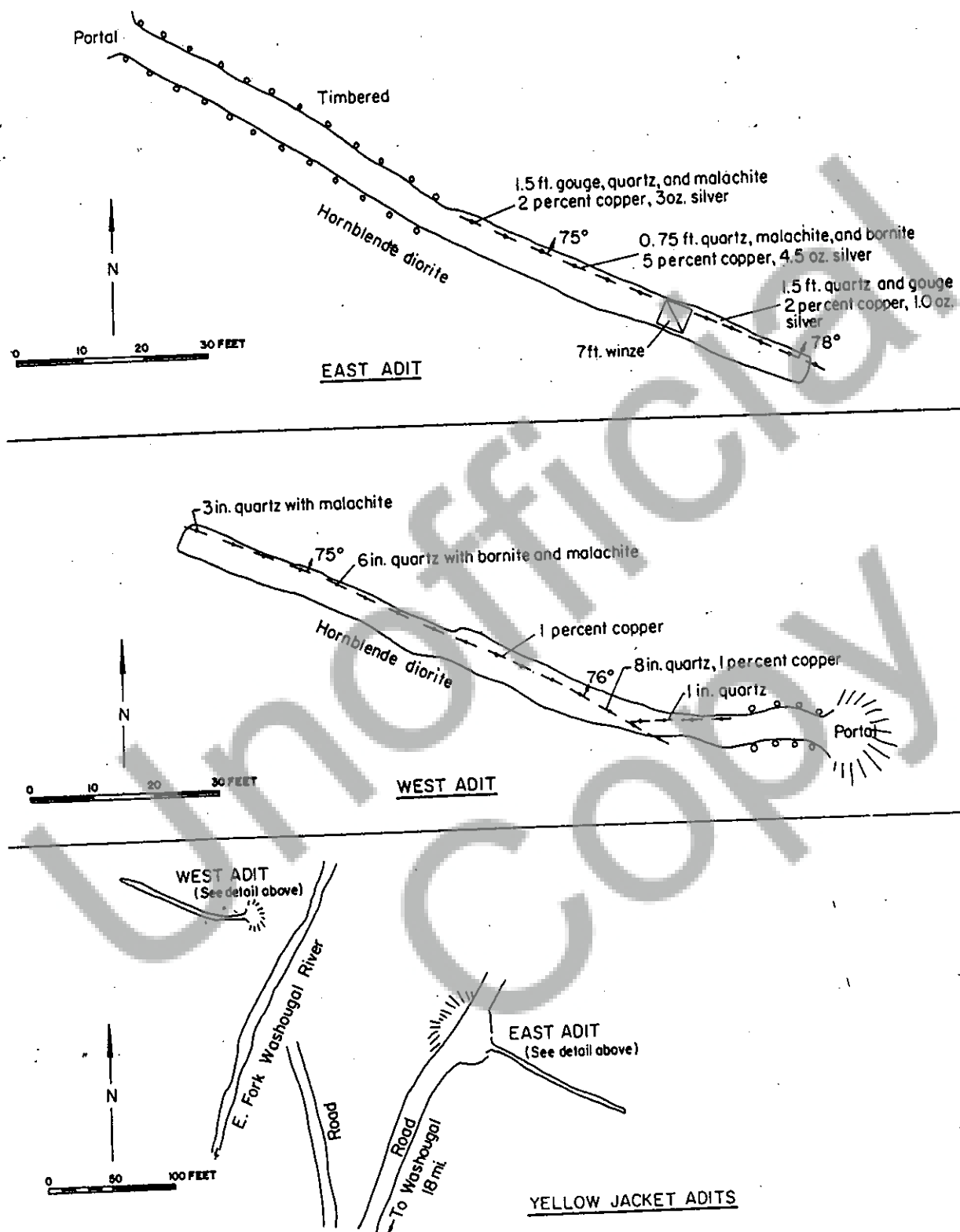


FIGURE 25.—Yellow Jack adits.
