The Planning Department issued a final Administrative Decision on May 5, 2004, for NSA-04-08. In materials received by our Department on September 20, 2004, (see attached page 4) you requested an amendment to the above-mentioned Administrative Decision. The amendment you have requested is to relocate the proposed 120 sq. ft. addition from the rear to the east side of the cabin and increase the size by 53 sq. ft. (10'x 14' addition with 33 sq. ft. steps and deck entrance). The addition will be located no closer to Wauna Lake than the existing cabin is now.

Pursuant to SCC §22.06.080(B), a change or alteration to an approved action, if determined to be minor by the Director, may be "deemed consistent with the provisions of this Title and the findings and conclusions on the original application." I have determined that the proposed request constitutes a minor change; therefore, the original decision shall be amended to allow a relocation of the proposed 120 sq. ft. addition from the rear to the east side of the cabin and increase the size by 53 sq. ft.

The site plan (see attached page 5) to this Letter Amendment shall replace the site plan attached to the original Administrative Decision of May 5, 2004, and shall be known as the final site plan. The amendment is hereby approved.

All of other conditions in the original Administrative Decision are still valid and shall be complied with. This amendment does include a 20-day appeal period (see below). Also, as a reminder, this Letter Amendment must be recorded at the County Auditor's office with legal descriptions attached prior to issuance of any building permits.

NOTES

Any new residential development, related accessory structures such as garages or workshops, and additions or alterations not included in this approved site plan, will require a new application and review.

As per SCC §22.06.050(C)(5), the decision of the Director approving a proposed development action shall become void in two years if the development is not commenced within that period, or when the development action is discontinued for any reason for one continuous year or more.

The Director reserves the right to provide additional comment and findings of fact regarding this decision, if appealed.
