

Notice of Location of the RB-23 (Quartz Lode) Mining Claim

State of Washington, County of Skamania, St. Helens Mining District

The Discovery Monument of RB-23 Quartz Lode Mining Claim, upon which this Notice of Location is posted, is located in the SW ¼ of Section 32 of Township 11 N, Range 6 E. The number of linear feet claimed in length each way from the Discovery Monument is 50 feet in a E direction and 1450 feet in a W direction, together with 300 feet on each side of the claim center-line. The general course of the lode or vein is in a E - W direction.

The approximate area of the claim intended to be appropriated is described as follows, to wit: Beginning at corner No. 1, the NE corner located in the SW ¼ of Section 32 of Township 11 N, Range 6 E, thence in a SE direction 600 feet to corner No. 2, the SE corner located in the SW ¼ of Section 32 of Township 11 N, Range 6 E, thence in a SW direction 1500 feet to corner No. 3, the SW corner located in the SW ¼ of Section 32 of Township 11 N, Range 6 E, thence in a NW direction 600 feet to corner No. 4, the NW corner located in the SW ¼ of Section 32 of Township 11 N, Range 6 E, thence in a NE direction 1500 feet to corner No. 1, the NE corner, the place of beginning.

The following reference is hereby made to natural objects and permanent monuments so as to identify said claim, to wit: The discovery monument is located 17,413 feet in a S66°E direction from Vanson Peak.

The adjoining claims are the RB-24 on the East, RB-22 on the West, RB-27 on the South, and the RB-20 on the North.
