# CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL:

The following conditions are required to ensure that the subject request is consistent with Skamania County Title 22. This document, outlining the conditions of approval, must be recorded, by the applicant, in the deed records of the Skamania County Auditor in order to ensure notice of the conditions of approval to successors in interest. SCC §22.06.050(C)(2).

- As per SCC §22.06.050(C)(2), this Administrative Decision **SHALL BE RECORDED** by the applicant in the County deed records prior to commencement of the approved project. A copy of the first page of the recorded Administrative Decision must be submitted to the Planning Department prior to issuance of a utility permit.
- 2) All developments shall be consistent with the enclosed site plan, unless modified by the following conditions of approval. If modified, the site plan shall be consistent with the conditions of approval. (See attached)
- 3) All disturbed areas are to be re-seeded with a native vegetation mix once the cable has been placed in the ground
- The applicant shall be responsible for the proper maintenance and survival of any vegetation required to be planted. Dead and dying vegetation shall be replaced in kind.
- The existing tree cover shall be retained as much as possible, except as is necessary for site development, safety purposes or as part of forest management practices.
- The applicant shall call for a final inspection upon project completion, to ensure compliance with all conditions. The applicant shall coordinate all inspections with the Planning Department at (509) 427-9458. Planning Department staff should be able to conduct a final inspection site visit within four business days from the time of calling for the inspection.
- 7) The following procedures shall be effected when cultural resources are discovered during construction activities:
  - a) Halt Construction. All construction activities within 100 feet of the discovered cultural resource shall cease. The cultural resources shall remain as found; further disturbance is prohibited.
  - Notification. The project applicant shall notify the Planning Department and the Cornec Commission within 24 hours of the discovery. If the cultural resources are prehistorically otherwise associated with Native Americans, the project applicant shall also notify the Indian tribal governments within 24 hours.
  - c) Survey and Evaluations. The Gorge Commission shall arrange for the cultural resources survey.
