### QUITCLAIM DEED and BILL OF SALE

THIS DEED made this Aday of America, 2006, between the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, Department of Energy, Bonneville Power Administration, (Bonneville) hereinafter called Grantor, and PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 1 OF SKAMANIA COUNTY (Skamania) hereinafter called Grantee.

NOW THEREFORE, Grantor, hereby remises, releases, and quitclaims unto the Grantee, its successors and assigns, all Grantor's right, title, interest and claim in and to the Grantor's Cape Horn Substation Site (Substation) situated in SE1/4SW1/4 and SW1/4SE1/4 of Section 3 and NE1/4NW1/4 and NW1/4NE1/4 Section 10, Township 1 North, Range 5 East, Willamette Meridian, Skamania County, Washington, as more particularly described as follows:

Parcel 1: All that portion of SE1/4SW1/4 of Section 3 and NE1/4NW1/4 of Section 10, Township 1 North, Range 5 East, Willamette Meridian, Skamania County, Washington, lying southerly and easterly of the Public Road known and designated as the Washington State Highway Route Number 140. The above portion of land contains 7.6 acres more or less, as recorded on May 23, 1975, in Book 68, Page 916, Records of Deed, No.79331, Skamania County, Washington and

Parcel 2: All that part of SW1/4SE1/4 of Section 3, Township 1 North, Range 5 East, Willamette Meridian, Skamania County, Washington, described as beginning at a point which is North 07°31'10" East, 281.77 feet from the south one quarter corner of Section 3. This corner is evidenced by a 1-inch Iron Pipe with Brass Cap. Thence North 87°39'50" East, 200.0 feet; thence South 02°20'10" East, 282.0 feet; thence South 88°40'40" West, 248.3 feet to the South one quarter corner of Section 3, thence North on the west line of the SW1/4SE1/4 of Section 3, to the Southerly right-of-way line of

Washington State Route Number 140; thence Northeasterly along the Southerly right-of-way of said highway to a point that is North 02°20'10" West, 80 feet more or less from the point of beginning; thence South 02°20'10" East, 80 feet more or less to the point of beginning. Said land contains 1.59 acres more or less, as recorded on April 25, 1975, in Book 68, Page 767, Records of Deed, No.79078, Skamania County, Washington, and

Parcel 3: All that part of the NW1/4NE1/4 of Section 10, Township 1 North, Range 5
East, Willamette Meridian, Skamania County, Washington, described as beginning at the north one-quarter corner of Section 10, which is evidenced by 1-inch Iron Pipe with Brass Cap. Thence North 88°40'40" East, 248.3 feet; thence South 02°20'10" East, 118.0 feet; thence South 87°39'50" West, 252 feet more or less to the west line of NW1/4NE1/4 of Section 10, thence North on said west line to the north one quarter corner of Section 10 being the point of beginning. Said land contains 0.69 acre more or less, as recorded on April 23, 1975 in Book 68, Page 741, Records of Deed, No.79066, Skamania County, Washington.

Parcel # 1-5-10-36

This grant is further subject to the terms and conditions contained in the Agreement for Disposition of said Substation between the Parties executed on 17<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2005.

RESERVING, to the Grantor and its assigns, a perpetual easement and right to enter including ingress and egress, inspect, operate, maintain, repair, replace and/or upgrade the existing Grantor equipment within the Cape Horn Substation site. The Grantee may continue to use Grantor's easement area for substation purposes, including keeping the existing substation equipment within the easement area.

RESERVING, also, to the Grantor a permanent easement over the entire facility at Cape Horn Substation and the established access road for the purpose to enter and erect, operate, maintain, repair, rebuild, and patrol one or more electric power transmission lines and appurtenant signal lines, poles, towers, wires, cables, and appliances necessary in connection therewith, in, upon, over, under, and across the substation and road for the existing overhead transmission line.

SUBJECT TO, easements and reservations for public roads and highways, public utilities, railroads, pipelines and other encumbrances of record, and also existing easements, if any, not shown of record.

IN ADDITION, Grantor releases and conveys to Grantee the improvements located thereon and as described in the attached Exhibit A, incorporated herein by reference. The improvements located thereon and retained by the Grantor are described in the attached Exhibit B.

IN ADDITION, Commencing on December 1, 2005, Skamania, or its successors, assumes responsibility for, and shall indemnify and hold Bonneville harmless against all environmental

clean-up costs in the Substation arising from (a) any activity of Bonneville or Skamania or its successors, at the Substation occurring prior to the date the Quitclaim Deeds and Bills of Sale are delivered to Skamania, including properly identifying, handling, removing and disposing of any releases of hazardous materials or petroleum products, or both, at the Substation; (b) any activity of Skamania or its successors, at the Substation occurring after the date the Quitclaim Deeds and Bills of Sale are delivered to Skamania, including properly identifying, handling, removing and disposing of any releases of hazardous materials or petroleum products, or both, at the Substation; and (c) any changes in environmental regulations or any changes in land use from a substation to another use.

The true consideration for this conveyance is \$262,823.00.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Grantor, by its duly authorized representative has executed this deed pursuant to the delegation of authority promulgated in by the Acts of August 20, 1937, (50 Stat. 733, 16 U.S.C. § 832a), as amended, and regulations, and delegations of authority issued pursuant thereto the provisions of which have been met, having been determined that the conveyance is in the public interest and will not be adverse to the interests of the United States.

This instrument does not authorize use of the property described in this instrument in violation of applicable land use laws and regulations. Before signing or accepting this instrument, the person acquiring fee title to the property should check with the appropriate city or county Planning Department to verify approved uses.
