#### QUITCLAIM DEED and BILL OF SALE

THIS DEED made this /5 day of March, 2006, between the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, Department of Energy, Bonneville Power Administration, (Bonneville) hereinafter called Grantor, and PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 1 OF SKAMANIA COUNTY (Skamania) hereinafter called Grantee.

NOW THEREFORE, Grantor, hereby remises, releases, and quitclaims unto the Grantee, its successors and assigns, all Grantor's right, title, interest and claim in and to the Grantor's Stevenson Substation Site (Substation) situated in W1/2NE1/4NW1/4, and Lots 8 and 9 of the Ignaz Wachter Subdivision, of Section 36, Township 3 North, Range 7 East, Willamette Meridian, Skamania County, Washington, as more particularly described as follows:

Substation Site Parcel 1: All that portion of the W1/2NE1/4NW1/4 of Section 36, Township 3 North, Range 7 East, Willamette Meridian, Skamania County, Washington, lying Northwesterly of Tract No. BC-27 of the Bonneville Power Administration Bonneville-Coulee transmission line right of way, as shown in an amended Lis Pendens filed in the District Court of the United States for the Western District of Washington, Southern Division, Cause No. 34, dated December 26, 1939, and recorded on January 5, 1940, in Book 27 of Deeds, Page 607, under Auditor's File No. 28306, records of Skamania County, Washington. (Warranty Deed recorded on February 13, 1975, in Book 68, Page 372, No. 78773, Records of Deed in Skamania, County, Washington.)

Substation Access Road: All that portion of Lot 8 of the Ignaz Wachter Subdivision of Section 36, Township 3 North, Range 7 East, Willamette Meridian, Skamania County, Washington, lying Northwesterly of the Bonneville Power Administration's Stevenson Substation Site and Northerly of a line 25 feet Southerly and parallel with a survey line described as follows: Beginning at a point which bears South 11°06'10" West, 432.57

feet from a 5/8 inch iron rod set to monument the Southeast corner of the SW1/4SW1/4 of Section 25, Township 3 North, Range 7 East, Willamette Meridian, thence North 67°30' West 140 feet; thence on a l00-foot radius curve to the left with 23° central angle a distance of 40.14 feet; thence South 89°30' West, 419 feet to a point in the County Road No. 2060 which bears South 58°06'30" East, 765.15 feet from brass cap monumenting the northwest corner of Section 36. (Warranty Deed recorded on February 13, 1975, in Book 68, Page 367, No. 78769, Records of Deed in Skamania, County, Washington.)

Substation Access Road Parcel 2: All the portion of Lot 8 of the Ignaz Wachter Subdivision of Section 36, Township 3 North, Range 7 East, Willamette Meridian, Skamania County, Washington, lying Easterly of the center line of the Skamania County Road No. 2060 (Maple Way Road) and Southerly of the Bonneville Power Administration Stevenson Substation Entrance Road right-of-way and Northwesterly of a line described as follows: Beginning at a point on the South edge of said entrance road right-of-way that bears South 58°29'00" East, 820.3 feet from a brass cap monumenting the northwest corner of said Section 36; thence South 44°30' West. (Warranty Deed recorded on March 14, 1975, in Book 68, Page 507, No. 78887, Records of Deed in Skamania, County, Washington.)

Substation Access Road Parcel 3: All that portion of Lot 9 of the Ignaz Wachter Subdivision of Section 36, Township 3 North, Range 7 East, Willamette Meridian, Skamania County, Washington, lying Easterly of the center line of Skamania County Road No. 2060 (Maple Way Road) and Northerly of the Bonneville Power Administration Stevenson Substation Entrance Road right-of-way, and Southwesterly of a line described as follows: Beginning at point on the North edge of said entrance road right-of-way that bears South 61°33'30" East, 795.4 feet from brass cap monumenting the Northwest corner of Section 36; thence North 45°30' West. (Warranty Deed recorded on May 2, 1975, in Book 68, Page 807, No. 79133, Records of Deed in Skamania, County, Washington.)

Also: That part of the following described tract of land located in the N1/2 NW1/4 of Section 36, Township 3 North, Range 7 East, Willamette Meridian, Skamania County, Washington, being parts of Lot 8 and Lot 9 of the Ignaz Wachter Subdivision and part of the W1/2NE1/4NW1/4 of said Section 36, particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the northwest corner of the W1/2NE1/4NW1/4 of said Section 36, thence North 88°28'30" East, a distance of 220.10 feet to the true point of beginning; thence South 30°17'00" East, a distance of 315.14 feet; thence South 41°52'50" West, a distance of 474.47 feet; thence North 48°07'10" West, a distance of 300.00 feet; thence North 41°52'50" East, a distance of 570.98 feet, more or less, to the true point of beginning, containing 3.60 acres more or less.

This grant is further subject to the terms and conditions contained in the Agreement for Disposition of said Substation between the Parties executed on day of day of 2005.

RESERVING, to the Grantor and its assigns, a perpetual easement and right to enter including ingress and egress, inspect, operate, maintain, repair, replace and/or upgrade the existing Grantor equipment within the Stevenson Substation site. The Grantee may continue to use Grantor's easement area for substation purposes, including keeping the existing substation equipment within the easement area.

RESERVING, also, to the Grantor a permanent easement over the entire facility and access road at Stevenson Substation to enter and erect, operate, maintain, repair, rebuild, and patrol one or more electric power transmission lines and appurtenant signal lines, poles, towers, wires, cables, and appliances necessary in connection therewith, in, upon, over, under, and across the substation for the existing overhead transmission line.

SUBJECT TO, easements and reservations for public roads and highways, public utilities, railroads, pipelines and other encumbrances of record, and also existing easements, if any, not shown of record.

IN ADDITION, Grantor releases and conveys to Grantee the improvements located thereon and as described in the attached Exhibit A, incorporated herein by reference. The improvements located thereon and retained by the Grantor are described in the attached Exhibit B.

IN ADDITION, Commencing on December 1, 2005, Skamania, or its successors, assumes responsibility for, and shall indemnify and hold Bonneville harmless against all environmental cleanup costs in the Substation arising from (a) any activity of Bonneville or Skamania or its successors, at the Substation occurring prior to the date the Quitclaim Deeds and Bills of Sale are delivered to Skamania, including properly identifying, handling, removing and disposing of any releases of hazardous materials or petroleum products, or both, at the Substation; (b) any activity of Skamania or its successors, at the Substation occurring after the date the Quitclaim Deeds and Bills of Sale are delivered to Skamania, including properly identifying, handling, removing and disposing of any releases of hazardous materials or petroleum products, or both, at the Substation; and (c) any changes in environmental regulations or any changes in land use from a substation to another use.

The true consideration for this conveyance is \$275,266.00.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Grantor, by its duly authorized representative has executed this deed pursuant to the delegation of authority promulgated in by the Acts of August 20, 1937, (50 Stat. 733, 16 U.S.C. § 832a), as amended, and delegations of authority issued pursuant

thereto the provisions of which have been met, having been determined that the conveyance is in the public interest and will not be adverse to the interests of the United States.

This instrument does not authorize use of the property described in this instrument in violation of applicable land use laws and regulations. Before signing or accepting this instrument, the person acquiring fee title to the property should check with the appropriate city or county Planning Department to verify approved uses.
