In construing this instrument, and whenever its context so requires, the singular includes the plural.

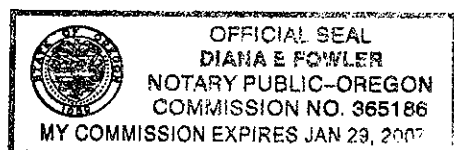
