Dear Kate Stevenson,

The Planning Department issued an Administrative Decision on February 6, 2006 for the above referenced application. On May 1, 2006 we received a letter from you requesting an amendment to alter the site plan to change the height of the communications tower from 120' to 133', as the approved 120' height elevation will not allow tenants to provide their service due to spacing requirements, to enlarge the equipment shelter from 12'x20' to 12'x40', and to expand the chain link enclosure to surround the entire communications complex, as shown on the revised site plan.

Pursuant to SCC §22.06.080(B), a change or alteration to an approved action, if determined to be minor by the Director, may be "deemed consistent with the provisions of this Title and the findings and conclusions on the original application."

The revised site plan, and tower elevation drawing (see attached pages 4 to 1) to this Letter Amendment shall replace the site plan attached to your original Administrative Decision of February 6, 2006. The amendment is hereby approved.

All of the original conditions not affected by this letter amendment in the Administrative Decision are still valid and shall be complied with. As a reminder, this letter amendment, along with the original Administrative Decision will need to be recorded at the County Auditor's office prior to any building permits being issued. LETTER AMENDMENT

SDS LUMBER COMPANY FILE NO: NSA-05-32

SDS Lumber Company submitted an application with the Skamania County Department of Planning and Community Development to erect a 120' communications tower, install a pre-fabricated equipment shelter and a 50' x 50' chain link fence around the compound. SDS' application was approved with conditions.

SDS would like to amend the application as follows:

Tower Height:

We must extend the tower height from 120' to 133', as the 120' height elevation will not allow tenants to provide their public service. There must be a minimum of 5 feet of spacing between carriers / tenants; a 120' tower allows only 3 feet of spacing.

Equipment Shelter:

We would like to enlarge the equipment shelter, providing a 12' x 40' shelter versus a 12' x 20' shelter. A larger shed will allow SDS to accommodate two tenants versus one tenant; we currently have two tenants that would like to provide service as soon as possible.

Chain Link Fence:


SDS originally applied for a 50' x 50' chain link fence. In order to accommodate future growth, we would like to expand the boundaries of the compound. Please see attached site map for details.

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


