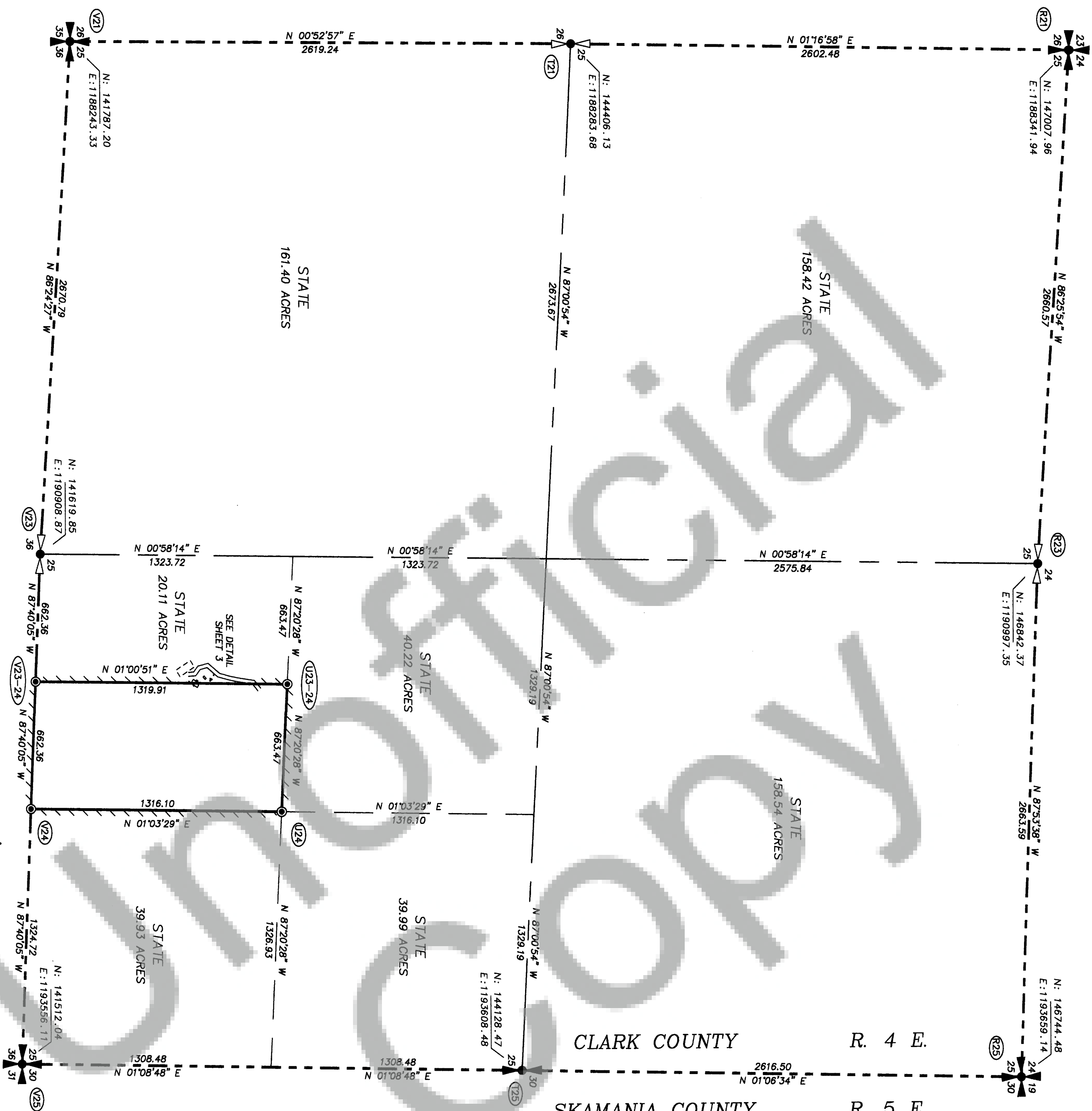

CONTROL, SPECIFICATIONS AND ACCURACY:

THIS SURVEY IS IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE FEDERAL GEODETIC CONTROL COMMITTEE'S "GEOMETRIC ACCURACY STANDARDS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR USING GPS RELATIVE POSITIONING TECHNIQUES, VERSION 5.0, REPRINTED WITH CORRECTIONS AUGUST 1, 1998," FOR GROUP C, ORDER 1 SURVEYS. FIELD OBSERVATIONS WERE MADE USING FOUR TRIMBLE 5700 GPS FIELD SURVEY RECEIVERS.

METHOD OF SURVEY:

THIS SURVEY WAS DONE BY FIELD TRAVERSE USING A TOPCON GT-503AF 3 SECOND TOTAL STATION. TRAVERSES WERE CLOSED LOOPS OR CLOSED BETWEEN KNOWN POINTS. LINEAR AND ANGULAR CLOSURES EXCEEDED THOSE SHOWN IN WAC 332-130-090 FOR LAMBERT GRID TRAVERSES. CORNER MONUMENTS TIED AND MONUMENTS SET WERE CHECKED BY DOUBLE MEASURES OF BOTH DIRECTION AND DISTANCE.

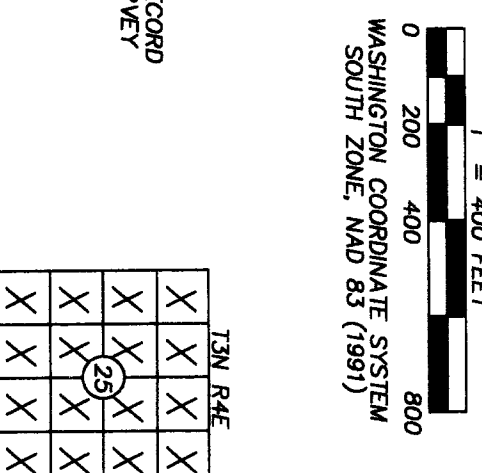
POSTED LINE:

MARRATIVE:

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY IS TO SUBDIVIDE SECTION 25 TO LOCATE AND MARK THE BOUNDARY LINES AROUND THE EAST HALF OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER. DURING THIS SURVEY I FOUND A 1966 DNR RIGHT OF WAY PLAT (N-1-L-1550) BY WILLIAM MURDOCK. IN SECTION 36 WHICH SHOWED THAT THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 25 AND 36 WAS FOUND WITH 2 BEARING TREES, BUT IT WAS NOT MONUMENTED. ON 9-07-06 THIS SURVEY FOUND THE MURDOCK POSITION FOR THE CORNER WHERE THERE IS A BEARING TREE PATTERN WHICH FITS A POSITION, WHERE I FOUND A 22" DIAMETER DEAD FIR SNAG STANDING 50 FOOT, THAT HAD RED FLAGGING IN AN OVERGROWN FACE AND RED FLAGGING ON THE GROUND UNDER THE DUFF. WHEN I CUT OUT THE FACE I FOUND APPROXIMATELY 38 YEARS OF OVERGROWTH, WHICH WOULD PLACE THE AGE OF THE FACE TO ABOUT THE TIME OF THE 1966 PLAT. AFTER FURTHER EVALUATION OF THIS POSITION I FOUND IT TO NOT FIT THE GLO FIELD NOTES WHICH PLACED THE CORNER IN A CREEK. THE CALCULATED SINGLE PROPORTION POSITION WAS 85 FEET NORTH AND 25 FEET WEST OF THIS POSITION. I DECIDED TO DO ANOTHER SEARCH OF THE AREA AND FOUND TWO HEWLOCK STUMPS THAT FIT CLOSE TO BEARINGS AND DISTANCES AND ALSO FIT THE GLO FIELD NOTES PLACING THE CORNER IN THE CREEK. THIS POSITION WAS CLOSER TO THE SINGLE PROPORTION POSITION, WHICH WAS 31 FEET NORTH AND 10 WEST. THIS POSITION ALSO FITS THE GLO CREEK CALL TO EAST OF 10.25 CHAINS (676 FEET). IN CONCLUSION I ACCEPTED AND MONUMENTED THIS POSITION FOR THE 1/4 BETWEEN SECTION 25 AND 36.

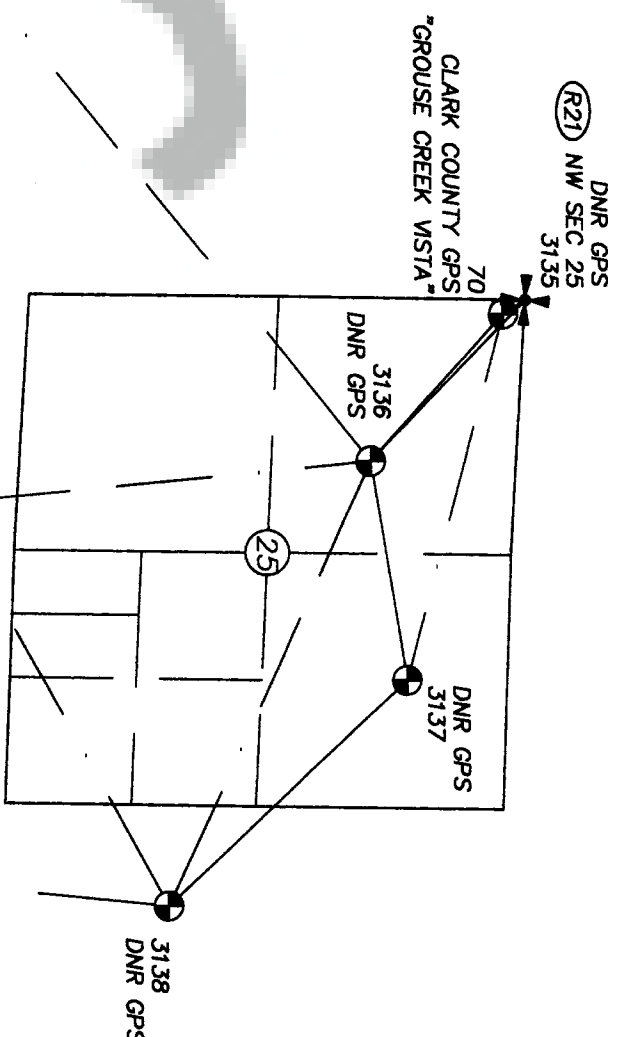


DETAIL OF OCCUPATION

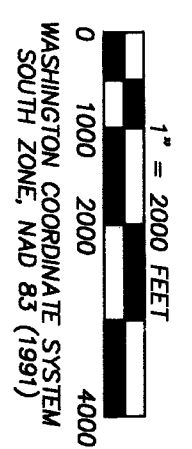
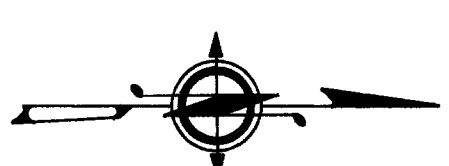
