Friday, July 28th, 2006, the Clark-Skamania Drug Task Force, while executing a search warrant at the above referenced address, confiscated an illegal methamphetamine drug lab.

The Skamania County Health Department has received and reviewed the "Completion Report" from A Best Construction, dated November 30, 2006.

To the best of my knowledge, the information upon which the property was originally declared "unfit for use" has been addressed by decontamination in accordance with procedures deemed appropriate by the Skamania County Health Department Health Officer.

The above documentation and inspection verifies reduction of contamination to acceptable levels for reuse as stated in the Washington State Department of Health, Office of Toxic Substances, <u>Guidelines for Contamination Reduction and Sampling at Illegal Drug Manufacturing Sites.</u>

As the legal owner, you are responsible for notifying all future inhabitants, renters, home purchasers, or real estate agents that the property was used as an illegal drug lab. A fact sheet about illegal methamphetamine labs is included with this letter.
