- I, Leslie M. Russell, Secretary of Water Front Recreation, Inc., a Washington corporation, being first duly sworn, on oath, depose and state:
- 1. On or about February 15, 1978, Water Front Recreation, Inc., as "Lessor", entered into a Cabin Site Lease with John H. Klein, as "Lessee", which lease was recorded in Book 6 at Page 17 in Skamania County, Washington records on August 24, 1978, and was for the following described cabin site ("Cabin Site 199"):

Cabin Site No. 199 of the North Woods being part of Government lots 4 and 8, Section 26, Township 7, North Range 6 East, W.M. Skamania County, subject, however to an easement for right of way for access road by the United States of America.

- The Lessee under the above-described lease ceased making lease 2. payments on or about 1984. At such time, the Lessee abandoned the lease and premises and Water Front Recreation, Inc. retook possession of the leased premises. Since that retaking, Lessee has not had nor reasserted any right, title, or interest in Cabin Site 199.
- On or about September 7, 1993, Water Front Recreation, Inc., as Lessor, 3. entered into a Cabin Site Lease with Richard L. and Martha J. Fields, as Lessee, covering Cabin Site 199, which lease was not recorded, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A. By Assignment dated November 14, 1996, the lease was assigned to Dan McFarland. By Assignment dated March 20, 1997, the lease was assigned to Ronald and Cheryl Myers. By Assignment dated November 13, 2003, the lease was assigned to Dean and Mari Wagstaff, the current Lessee.

SECTION 4. LESSOR'S COVENANTS

3.01 Dectaration. In order to preserve the natural beauty of the North Woods, to provide for the control of structures erected thereon, improvements to be made thereon, and for the purpose of extending to the residents therein the greatest possible peace, enjoyment, privacy, health, comfort, safety, and preservation of property values. Lessur does hereby certify and declare that the following reservations, conditions, cavenants, agreements and restrictions shall become and are hereby made a part of all lesses of property within the plat of the North Woods as the same appears on the map survey recorded in the office of the County Auditor of Skamania County, Washington.

SECTION 4. USE OF SITE

- 4.07 Permitted Use. The cabin site shall be used only for residential purposes. No building shall be erected, altered, placed, or permitted to remain on the cabin site other than one detacted single family dwelling and buildings incidental to residential use, and the cabin site shall not be further subdivided into building lots.
- 4.02 Condition of Site. The promises hereby leased have been inspected by Leases and are accepted in their present condition.
- 4.03 Vehicles. No vehicles shall be parked in readways. Vehicles shall not be operated carefussly or in excess of posted speeds. No vehicle shall be operated at anytime without a multier in good working order. Excessive motor noise or annoying snoke are forbidden.
- 4.04 Maintenance. All loss shall at all times be kept in a clear, sightly, and wholesome condition and no trash, garbago. litter, junk, boxes, containers boxies, cars, machinery, implements, lumber, or other building materials shall be permitted to be or remain exposed on any lot and visible from any street or adjoining or nearby premise.
- 4.05 Signu. No signs of any kind shall be displayed to the public view on any lot in the trace except one professional sign, of not more than 18 inches by 24 inches in size, advertising the property for sale or rent, and except signs used by a builder or developer to advertise the property during the construction and sales period.
- 4.06 Nuisance. No notious of offensive trade or activity shall be carried on at upon any lot in the tract not shall anything be done thereon which may be or become an annoyance or nuisance in the area.
- 4.07 Animats. No animate, ilvestock or poultry of any kind shall be raised, or kept on any lot, except that cats, dogs, or other household pets may be kept, but not for any commercial purpose. Household pets shall not be allowed to become an anneyance or nuisance to the neighborhood.

- 4.08 Inclineration. Because of unpleasant adors and unsightliness, no individual incinerator will be permitted on any lot.
- 4.09 Fires and Fireplaces. Interior freplaces, stower, or other type burner must be fireprecised by use of sparkproof screens. All fires must be extinguished before leaving cabin. No fires shall be lit or maintained outside of any cabin.
- 4.10 Firenza and Fireworks. Dissinarging firenzas, Recrackers, rockers or any other fireworks within the North Woods area shall be prohibited.
- 4.11 Commercial Use. No placed tot shall be used for any commercial purpose, except that Lexies may rent his cabin from time to time, and in such case shall be responsible that his tartents abide by these covenants.
- 4.12 Motorbikes. No mojorbike or motorcycle ricing of any nature shall be allowed except for impress and egress.
- 4.19 Fire Extinguisher. One line entinguisher (minimum two quart capacity) must be kept in every cabin.
- 4.14 Trailers and Tents. No rent, house trailer, or mobile home, whether the same be on wheels or not, shall be permitted on any for except during the period of capin construction and for guess over a weekend period.
- 4.15 Solle(tation. There shall be no solicitation or distribution of handbills or circulation of any kind without the written consent of Lessor.
- 4.16 Hose Blbs. One have bit shall be installed an outside wall of each cabin for fire protection on or before completion.
- 4.17 Miscellaneous Prohibitions. Electric generators (except for occasional dayline use), garbage disposals, and crothes wasners are strictly prohibited.

SECTION 5. IMPROVEMENTS

- 5.01 Plans approved. No building shall be erected, placed, or altered on the cabin site until the construction plans showing the jocation of the structure have been approved by the Lessor as to conformity with plan of development, quality of workmanship and materials, hermony of external design and color with existing structures, and as to location with respect to topography and finish grade elevation. Such approval shall be in writing.
- 5.02 Building Materials. All huilding construction shall be of log or wood frame. Wend frame stucco or simulated brick veneer construction is expressly prohibited. All reafs shall be of wood siringle or strake, or of an acceptable composition color to be approved prior to application by the Lesson or such person or persons designated by Lesson.
- 5.03 Completion. Cabins must be completed from all outward appearance within one (1) year from the time such construction is started. Cabin construction must be started within three years from the cate of the signing of Cabin Site Lease.
- 5.04 Tree Removal. The Lesses of each cabin site may remove from said site all trace, shrubs, and follage necessary to prepare the property for building subject to the following conditions:

As required by the State of Washington in the Master Lease, any tree whose diameter is ever 8" at chest height must be marked by Lesses for Leaser's inspection. Leaser will then notify the Washington State Department of Natural

Resources and request their standard appraisal of value. Lesses will then pay Lesses for the value of the tree before removal. Any additional clearing beyond that necessary for the construction improvements shall be prohibited. The intent is to remove as few trees as possible to the end that the community remain natural and custic.

- 5.05 Lot Markers. Lesses will use all reasonable care to make certain that the foll markers, as established by Lesser, are not moved or destroyed.
- 5.06 Improvements Other Than On Cabin Sits. No improvements of any kind shall be constructed or placed upon any area covered by the Master Lesse without Lesser's prior willian consent.
 - 5.97 Ownership of Improvements. The Master Lease provides as follows:
 - Ownership of Sub-lessee Improvements. All buildings and Improvements. excluding removeble personal property and trade features on the leased alle [North Woods] greated by Sub-lessee [Lastree herein] will remain on said site after expiration of this leave (Master Lease) or birmination prior to the term of this lease [Master Lease] of any sub-lease [this lease] held by the State under the provisions of paragraph 5.08; provided, however, upon the expiration of the lease [Master Lease), if the State is unsuccessful in re-leasing the leased site (North Woods), as a unit, then each sub-lessee (Lessee herein) shall have a preferential right as allowed by law to re-lease from the State in sub-leased area; provided, further, upon the formination or expiration of this lease [Master Lease] or a sub-lease [this lease] assigned under paragraph 5.09 that as a condition of any re-lease of the leased site or sub-leased site to any other party made during the firee year period following the State shall require the subsequent Lesses to purchase the Sublessee's [Lesses herein] interest in the improvements as allowed by law. Expiration, as used in this paragraph, shall mean the expiration of the lease as of May 31, 2069.

The parties mireto agree that the terms and conditions of the above quoted paragraph shall be applicable provided:

(a) That Lessee is not in default under any of the terms and conditions of this lesse; and (b) That Lessee's lesse expires May 31, 2009. In the event of earlier expiration of this lesse, all buildings and improvements located upon the premises shall be the property of Lesser.

The parties hereto further agree that the benefits of paragraph 8.04 of the Master Lease shall be enforceable solely.

- G.04 Taxes and Assessments. The Leases shall pay in arrival payments at taxes and essessments that are now charged or may become chargeable against the improvements placed upon the cabin site. now or in the future, commending with the taxes first becoming due and payable after the date hereof, all potons such taxes and assessments become past due.
- S.OH North Woods Association. The roads in the plat and certain other common areas shall be held in the name of the North Woods Association, a non-profit association, of which the Lessess of less in the plat shall be members. Said Association shall be responsible for the maintenance and repair of roads, the artile water system serving the cabins on the premises, docks and common states and improvements thereon (if any), as well as other community functions which may be given it by its members. The owners (Lesses) of lats in the tract shall be required to pay dues of not less than one and one-half dollars (1-1/2) per month and assessments to said Association for their reasonable share of the costs of the functions and duties of the Association.

SECTION 6. UTILITIES

- 6.01 Servage. Individual sewage disposel systems installed by Lassee must be designed, located, and constructed in accordance with the regulations, laws and ordinances of Skamania County and the State of Washington.
- 6.02 Reservation. Lessor reserves to itself and to its successors and assigns essemants in under, and along all reads and other common areas in the plat for any utilities whether presently installed or not. In addition, an essement is reserved in an area five (5) feet by ten (10) feet in one corner of each lot to be selected by Lessor) adjoining the read, for electric transformer vault and/or talephone and power service pedestals if any. And the essegrament of the lease as to each individual lot shall be subject to the right to cross over or under the same along the lot lines, with utility lines if such may be necessary in the development of this subdivision or explaining subdivisions.
- 6.03 Water. Each cabin site has or will be furnished water at or near the lot line. Each lesses agrees to receive water from the water system supplying the North Woods and further agrees to pay Lessor \$225.00 for the right to connect to paid system.
- 6.04 Maintenance. The leases shall bear the responsibility and expense of furnishing, installing, backfilling, and maintening each underground tenant or other digging upon such cabin site which is necessary for any utility connections or facilities to serve such cabin site.

SECTION 7. MISCELLANEOUS

- 7.01 Lessee's Duties. Lesses agrees to comply strictly with the Lesser's rules and regulations and all applicable Federal, State. County, and Municipal laws, rules and regulations relating to all activities contemplated under this lease, including but not limited to, use of public or private roads, parking, fire and prevention of fire, public health, and pollution of streams or lakes, and to assume all ortigations thereby imposed upon the Lesser. Lesser may largest the cabin also and cabin at any time to obtain a compliance with the terms of this lease.
- 7.02 Indemnification. Lesses hereby agrees to assume all risk of, and indemnify and hold harmless, and at the Lesses's expense, detend the Lesses from and against, any claims, less, code, legal actions, liability or expense on or damage to or destruction of property to whomsoever belonging, including but not limited to, employees at the Lesses of damage to or destruction of property to whomsoever belonging, including but not limited to property of the Lesses which might result from Lesses's activities on the leased premises. The Lesses further agrees to indemnify and save harmless the Lesses from any loss, costs, suit or expense resulting from Lesses's failure to comply with any of the provisions of any applicable laws, rules or regulations.
 - 7.03 Insurance. Lessos shall obtain fire, casually and fability insurance as follows:
 - (a) Fire and casually insurance in a sufficient amount to cover the replacement cost of any or all improvements upon the lease pramises. Such insurance shall be carried by a responsible company or companies satisfactory to Lessor and the policy or policies shall be endorsed and delivered to Lessor with provision for thinly (30) days notice of cancellation to Lessor.
 - (b) Liability and property insurance insuring Lessor and Lessoe against all liability for damages to persons or property caused by the maintenance, use or occupancy of the leased premises or by reason of the canduct of any activity catried on therein. Such insurance shall be carried by a responsible company or companies satisfactory to Lessor in amounts not less than the following limits, namely:
 - (1) Bodily injury to or death of any one person, \$50,000,00;
 - (2) Bodily injury or death resulting from any one accident to two or more persons, \$50,000.00; and
 - (3) Property damage, \$50,000.

Lesses shall deliver to Lessor cartificates and recalps evidencing said policies of insulation and further provide

with the company or companies for thiny (30) days' notice of cancellation to Lessor.

- 7.04 Assignment. Without the prior written consent of Lesson, Lesson shall not assign this lease or any interest therein, or sublet, and no helf, executor, administrator, receiver, trustue in bankruptcy or other assignees by operation of law shall easign or sublease without such written consent.
- 7.05 Waiver. Any waiver by the Lessor of any provisions hereof must be in writing, and any of the covenants, conditions, restrictions, in this lesse may be annulled, waived, changed, or modified with respect to all or any portion of said property by Lessor at any time.
- 7.06 Attorneys' Fees. In the givent any action, suit, proceeding or appeal therefrom is brought to cullect the rent due or to become due hereunder or any portion thereof, or to get pressession of said premises, or to enforce compliance with this lesse, or for failure to observe any of the comments of this lesse, the prevailing party shall be entitled to recover such sum as the Coun may adjudge reasonable as attorneys' free to be allowed in said suit, action, proceeding or appeal therefrom in addition to such other relief granted by the Count.
- 7.07 Condemnation. The parties hereto shall receive any sums or damages paid or awarded by reason of any taking, condemnation or acquisition during the existence of this lesse as their interests therein shall then appear, whether or not by itigation, by any authority, person or corporation, whether public or private, of any title to or interest in all or any part of the premises.
- 7.08 Reservoir Level. The Leases acknowledges by signing this lease that Pacific Power and Light Company has the right to fluctuate the waters of Swift Reservoir at any time within the provision of Federal Power Commission License No. 2111 of as amended. The Leases shall waive all claims or damage and shall indemnify Pacific Power and Light Company, the State of Weshington, Leaser or their successors, if any, against any dam of Pacific Power and Light Company, the State of Weshington, Leaser or their successors, if any, against any dam of demage alieing from fluctuation in reservoir level or impairment of recreational use of the reservoir of shoreside at fleating tacilities.
- 7.09 Validity of Provisions. The determination of any Court that any provisions of this lease. are unaswful or void shall not affect the validity of any other provision hereof.
- 7.10 Entercement of Restrictions. Without in any way limiting the rights of Lesson, if the parties upon whom the provisions hereof are binding, or any of them, shall violate or attempt to violate any of the reservations, restrictions of covenants hereof, the Lesson or any lessee of land in the tract, shall have the right to compare performance of or compliance with the provisions hereof, to above and remove, at the expense of the attending lessee or lessees of the property, any saructures or erections in violation of the provisions hereof, to recover damages for any such violation or attempted violation of the provisions hereof and to proveduce any proceedings at law or in equity in furtherence of the attendated remarks in any Court having jurisdiction of such passes.
- 7.11. Reservations on Land. All of the recovations, conditions, coverants, agreements and testrictions shall with the land and shall be binding on the leasens of all properly covered hereby and all parties and persons claiming under them and on all properly within the test.

SECTION 8. TERMINATION
