Westbound on Highway 14, Skamania County, Washington.

5. My injury or damages were caused or happened as follows:

On 8-29-04, at approximately 3:00 p.m., Becky was traveling westbound on Highway 14 when she noticed a police car on the right hand side of the road far behind the yellow line. Becky observed the vehicle's lights on, but believed the vehicle was parked. Becky slowed as she approached the officer's vehicle. All of a sudden, Officer Tracy Wykcoff pulled out onto the road into oncoming traffic in front of Becky causing her to hit the officer's vehicle on the right rear portion of the driver's side at approximately 45 mph. Becky only had a moment to

make a decision to brake and hit the rear of the officer's vehicle in order to avoid a potential multi-car collision behind her.

## **Description of Conduct and Circumstances**

Upon impact, the airbags deployed and slammed into Becky's face and upper body. She remembers being thrown forward and blown back, and her left hand hitting the steering wheel or being jammed by the airbag. She recalls her car filling up with a powdery like substance. She could not see anything, but this powdery substance. She recalls the feeling of panic she experienced while being unable to see where her car was facing, or whether she was in or out of traffic. She sustained bruising on her left hand and burns on her face and neck from the airbag. Becky's vehicle was undriveable and towed from the scene of the collision.

The collision caused extensive damage to the front end of Becky's 2001 Volkswagen Jetta. The cost to repair her vehicle was approximately \$7,700.00.

For several weeks following the accident, Skamania County would not authorize a rental car for Becky while her vehicle was being repaired. She was inconvenienced as a result of having to borrow her parents' full size SUV vehicle for transportation purposes while her mother rented a vehicle. The cost to fuel her parents' borrowed SUV was double the amount she normally spent to fuel her diesel powered Volkswagen Jetta.

Although Becky's car was repaired, she feels she has suffered a diminished trade in value of approximately \$2,000.00 as a result of this collision.

In addition, Becky's terms racket was damaged from the force of the impact of the collision. The cost to re-string the racket was \$30,00.

Anterior neck pain where airbag deployed. Left wrist sprain Cervical and lumbar sprains

and as diagnosed by Pasa Chiropractic: 847.0; 847.10; 847.70; 847.3; and 729.10, which required chiropractic and massage therapy treatment for the period from 9-14-04 to 6-16-05.
