The name of the claim is: Yellow Jacket

Claim, further described* as follows:

Commencing at a post marked No. 1; then 600 feet in a South direction to a corner post marked No. 2; then 1500 feet in a East direction to a corner post marked No. 3; then 600 feet in a North direction to a corner post marked No. 4; then 1500 feet in a West direction to that corner post marked No. 1.

The locators claim direction from the point of discovery in the West and line and 300 feet on each side of the middle of the vein or lode, further claiming all the surface rights, privileges and minerals, with all dips, spurs, angles and variations, and other rights granted by existing laws and customs. This claim is further described as being 500 feet from the following natural object or permanent monument in the vicinity: A 40 foot water fall on Skamania Creek, below the old log bridge on Forest Road

The general course or strike of the vein or lode as nearly as may be determined is East with reference to the natural object or permanent monument described above.

This claim is situated in the NE (quarter section) of Section 21 Township 003 N Range 005 E of the Willamette Meridian, as surveyed by the U.S. Government or protracted if the land is unsurveyed.
