- 2. That the legally established prior nonconforming uses include, in addition to offroad vehicle riding and racing, private events, occasional customer appreciation days, employee events and the like, and the filming of commercial videos.
- 3. That the scope of the lawfully established prior nonconforming use includes administrative, management and maintenance activities, parking and camping associated with the foregoing activities, and related display and sale of products associated with those activities, and common daily consumer needs of spectators and participants. The nonconforming use also includes use of a public address system. This specification does not address every possible aspect of the nonconforming use; just because something is not mentioned does not mean it is not part of the nonconforming use.
- 4. That the lawfully established prior nonconforming uses include meandering track pathways (as opposed to concentrated areas of tracks such as the main track) that have been used for riding off-road vehicles throughout the site. The nonconforming use includes trails that were regularly "rested and rotated", although not continuously used at all times. However, the parties stipulate that the nonconforming right does not include operation of a 4X4 track, and 4X4 practices or 4X4 races on the property. This limitation is not intended to prevent WMX from submitting application to Clark County for regulatory approvals to conduct such activities.
- 5. That the geographical scope of the lawfully established prior nonconforming use constitutes the entirety of the approximately 220 acres comprising the WMX site, except as provided above.

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1	6. That these uses were conforming uses under Clark County's Zoning laws until		
2	January 1, 1995, at which time they became lawfully established prior nonconforming uses.		
3	7. The approximately 200-acre property on which Washougal MX is located is a		
4	"facility" for the purposes of WAC 173-60-050(3)(g). Process, events and activities occurred in		
5	established areas throughout the site prior to September, 1975. The "established area" or		
6	purposes of that WAC is the whole Washougal MX site. All noise from sanctioned racing event		
7	anywhere on the site is exempt from WAC 173-60-040. The noise exemption applies to all noise		
8	produced during a racing event (including practice races), not just vehicle noise. The referenced		
9	racing events were "sanctioned" by a "recognized" organization prior to September, 1975.		
10	Recognized organizations were the American Motorcyclist Association (AMA) and the		
11	Continental Motorcycle Association (CMC).		
12	8. That notwithstanding the foregoing, MX agrees to comply with the following		
13	requirements, except as those requirements are modified at the request of MX pursuant to a		
14	condition imposed in the approval of an application for a land use approval requested by MX:		
15	(a) At least 60 days prior to any Nationals event, including associated race activities in the week preceding (all of which are hereinafter referred to as "Nationals"), MX agrees		
16	to submit a transportation plan for Nationals to the Clark County Community  Development Department, or any changes proposed to the previous year's plan. At the		
17	request of either the County or MX, the County and MX shall meet at reasonable times and places at least 45 days prior to the event to answer questions regarding the plan and		
18	to discuss any modifications that either desire to the plan, and whether or how MX and		
19	the County will meet any reasonable requests for modifications to the plan. The plan shall include analysis as to the level of traffic control if any, needed based on the		
20	anticipated event size. A security plan shall be shall also be submitted by MX for the Nationals event, except that the plan shall be also submitted to the Clark County Sheriff.		
21	(b) At least 30 days prior to any Nationals event, an event plan, and a plan to provide
