DEFAULT JUDGMENT

This matter came before the Court on the Plaintiff's motion for entry of a default judgment against Defendants Chasz C. Coniber and Nichole Elizabeth Boyle. The amount of the judgment was not certain.

A hearing was held on Plaintiff's motion on February 27, 2008. Plaintiff appeared through his attorney of record, Gregory E. Price, and in person. No appearance was made by Defendants Chasz C. Coniber or Nichole Elizabeth Boyle in person or through an attorney. The Court considered the pleadings filed in this action, the proof of service on file, the declaration of Plaintiff's counsel, and the following evidence:

- 1. Order Granting Plaintiff's Motion for Summary Judgment on the Reasonableness and Necessity of Medical Treatment in the amount of \$995,628.59 entered on November 2, 2007, a copy of which was further admitted into evidence at the February 27, 2008 hearing ("the hearing") and marked as Exhibit 1.
- 2. Stipulated Order re: an additional \$5,859.00 in Reasonableness and Necessity of Medical Treatment entered February 8, 2008, bringing total medical expenses to \$1,001,487.59, a copy of which was further admitted into evidence at the hearing and marked as Exhibit 2.
- 3. Statement of Funeral Goods and Services from Brown's Funeral Home, dated May 3, 2002, confirming funeral expenses in the amount of \$8,786.27, which was admitted into evidence at the hearing and marked as Exhibit 3.
- 4. Invoice from Camas Cemetery Association and Warranty Deed dated June 6, 2002, confirming burial expenses in the amount of \$1,480.00, which was admitted into evidence at the hearing and marked as Exhibit 4.
- 5. Declaration of Eugene Silberberg, Ph.D., concerning the economic loss sustained by Richard King's family as a result of his death on May 2, 2002, which was

admitted into evidence at the hearing and marked as Exhibit 5.

- 6. Declaration of Robert S. Djergaian, M.D., concerning Richard King's injuries, care, treatment, and resulting death, which was admitted into evidence at the hearing and marked as Exhibit 6.
- 7. The testimony of Loren Brooks concerning funeral and burial expenses incurred by the Estate of Richard J. King as a result of his death on May 2, 2002.
- 8. The testimony of Tyler King concerning his relationship with his father, Richard J. King, and what his father reasonably would have been expected to contribute to him in the way of love, care, companionship, and guidance.
- 9. The testimony of Dawn Arthur concerning her relationship with her father, Richard J. King, and what her father reasonably would have been expected to contribute to her in the way of love, care, companionship, and guidance.
- 10. The testimony of Tabitha Richards concerning her relationship with her father, Richard J. King, and what her father reasonably would have been expected to contribute to her in the way of love, care, companionship, and guidance.
- I.1. The testimony of Tina Richards concerning her relationship with her father. Richard J. King, and what her father reasonably would have been expected to contribute to her in the way of love, care, companionship, and guidance.

Based on the argument of counsel, the pleadings and evidence presented, the Court makes the following findings of fact and conclusions of law:

- Defendants Chasz C. Coniber and Nichole Elizabeth Boyle were declared to be in default by the Court's order entered on November 2, 2007.
 - 2. Proof of service is on file in this action.
- 3. Defendants Chasz C. Coniber and Nichole Elizabeth Boyle are neither infants nor incompetent persons.
 - 4. Defendants Chasz C. Coniber and Nichole Elizabeth Boyle are not in military

service.

- 5. Plaintiff's decedent, Richard J. King, suffered significant injuries as a result of the automobile accident on May 30, 2001, proximately resulting in his paralysis and subsequent death on May 2, 2002.
- 6. As a proximate result of the automobile collision on May 30, 2001, Plaintiff's decedent, Richard J. King, incurred necessary medical care, treatment and services having a reasonable value of \$1,001,487.59.
- 7. As a proximate result of the automobile collision on May 30, 2001, the Estate of Richard J. King incurred funeral expenses totaling \$10,266.27.
- 8. As a proximate result of the automobile collision on May 30, 2001, and Richard J. King's resulting death on May 2, 2002, Richard J. King's family sustained economic losses totaling \$166,966.
- 9. Survivor claim of \$5,000,000.00 for Richard King's beneficiaries until his death on May 2, 2002.
- 10. Tyler King is a statutory beneficiary of Plaintiff's decedent, Richard J. King, under RCW 4.20.010, RCW 4.20.020 and RCW 4.20.060. As a proximate result of the automobile collision on May 30, 2001, and Richard J. King's resulting death on May 2, 2002, Tyler King suffered noneconomic damages in the total amount of \$500,000.
- 11. Dawn Arthur is a statutory beneficiary of Plaintiff's decedent, Richard J. King, under RCW 4.20.010, RCW 4.20.020 and RCW 4.20.060. As a proximate result of the automobile collision on May 30, 2001, and Richard J. King's resulting death on May 2, 2002, Dawn Arthur suffered noneconomic damages in the total amount of \$500,000.
- 12. Tabitha Richards is a statutory beneficiary of Plaintiff's decedent, Richard J. King, under RCW 4.20.010, RCW 4.20.020 and RCW 4.20.060. As a proximate result of the automobile collision on May 30, 2001, and Richard J. King's resulting death on May 2, 2002, Tabitha Richards suffered noncconomic damages in the total amount of \$500,000.

13. Tina Richards is a statutory beneficiary of Plaintiff's decedent, Richard J.

King, under RCW 4.20.010, RCW 4.20.020 and RCW 4.20.060. As a proximate result of the automobile collision on May 30, 2001, and Richard J. King's resulting death on May 2, 2002,

Tina Richards suffered noneconomic damages in the total amount of \$500,000.

Based on the above findings of fact and conclusions of law, Judgment is entered as follows:

1. Plaintiff Loren Brooks, as Personal Representative of the Estate of Richard L.

- Plaintiff Loren Brooks, as Personal Representative of the Estate of Richard J.
 King, is awarded judgment against Defendants Chasz C. Coniber and Nichole Elizabeth Boyle in the amount of \$8,178,719.70.
- 4. Plaintiff Loren Brooks, as Personal Representative of the Estate of Richard King, is awarded his costs in the amount of \$460.
