

NOTICE HEREBY IS GIVEN that the undersigned locators, each a citizen of the United States or one who has declared an intention to become such, have discovered on Sept 9th, 2008, a vein or lode of locatable mineral-bearing rock in place upon the public domain of the United States which is open to mineral entry and location within the above state, county and mining district; and in accordance with the laws of the United States and of the State of Washington, have located and do hereby locate a claim upon such vein or lode by posting this notice of such discovery and location on a substantial post or monument at the point of discovery. The name of the claim is: Rock of Ages Claim, further described* as follows:

Commencing at a post marked No. 1: At Discovery Lode
then 800 feet in a South West direction to a corner post marked No. 2,
then 600 feet in a East direction to a corner post marked No. 3,
then 1500 feet in a North direction to a corner post marked No. 4,
then 600 feet in a South West direction to that corner post marked No. 5
The locators claim then 1500' South to post #2 feet in a West direction from the point of discovery to the 50' West end line and 550' E from discovery
to E. End line feet on each side of the middle of the vein or lode, further claiming all the surface rights, privileges and minerals, with all dips, spurs, angles and variations, and other rights granted by existing laws and customs. This claim is further described as being 50 feet from the following natural object or permanent monument in the vicinity: FS Rd 29 to W End line and 550' from discovery post to East End line.
