RELEASE AGREEMENT
(SETTLEMENT AND GENERAL RELEASE OF ALL CLAIMS)

This Agreement, made on this 3rd day of November, 2008, by and between **SKAMANIA COUNTY** ("County"), a political subdivision of the State of Washington, **Riverview Community Bank** ("Claimants"),

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, on or about 3rd day of **November 2008**, the Claimant filed a claim with the Skamania County Auditor. In this Notice of Claim, the Claimant alleges in **August, 2008** that damage occurred to claimant from **negligent vehicle operation by a county employee hitting top of bus on bank awning causing damage to the awning.**

WHEREAS, Claimant claims they have been damaged as a result of this incident in the amount of **\$730.36 for damage to this awning.** A copy of Claimants' claim is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibits "A"; and


WHEREAS, the parties now desire to settle this claim and all other damages or injuries resulting from this incident;

NOW, THEREFORE, in compromise and settlement of the above claim, and all other claims, THE PARTIES HEREBY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. The County agrees to pay the Claimant the sum of \$730.36 to fully settle this claim. Said payment shall be in the form of a warrant made payable to **Riverview Community Bank, P O Box 10, Stevenson, WA 98648.**
2. The Claimants agree that all claims, demands, rights, and causes of action that they have or may have had or their insurance company have or may have had, including but not limited to any personal injury or property damage claims, against Skamania County are satisfied, discharged and settled.
3. This Agreement shall be binding on and inure to the benefit of the parties and their respective legal representatives, successors and assigns.
4. This Agreement is not to be construed as an admission by either side of liability, or as evidencing an admission of the truth or correctness of any claims asserted against Skamania County by the Claimants.
5. This Agreement shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Washington.
6. Any action at law, suit, inequity, or judicial proceeding for the enforcement of any provision of this Agreement shall be instituted only in the court with competent jurisdiction that lies in Skamania County, State of Washington.

7. This Agreement has been prepared by the combined efforts of all the parties and their respective representatives.
8. This Agreement embodies the entire agreement of the parties respecting the subject matter. There are no promises, terms, conditions or obligations other than those contained herein. This instrument supersedes all previous communications, representations, or agreements, either verbal or written, between the parties.
9. In the event any lawsuit or action becomes necessary to enforce or defend the terms of this Agreement, the prevailing party shall be entitled to recover all costs and expenses incurred by such party in connection therewith, including but not limited to reasonable attorneys fees.
