(1) Corner History:

On Oct. 7, 1875, Samuel J. Spray, Deputy Surveyor for the GLO set a post with the following accessories: a maple 10 inches diameter S 45 E 33 links, a willow 8 inches in diameter S 30 W 11 links. (Vol. WA-R0038, Pg 547) A June 24, 1914 map from the Office of State Highway Commissioner titled *Cooks to Collins* of State Road No. 8, shows a symbol at the East quarter corner and a distance South to the centerline of Highway 8 (SR 14) of 2099.8 feet. The distance from the corner to the centerline of present day SR 14 is found to be 2134.06 feet along the Section line.

The BLM performed a dependant resurvey of Section 31 dated September 2, 1983. The field work was performed form April 26, 1982 to May 21, 1982. The distance shown from the East quarter corner to the South 1/16 corner between Sections 31 and 32 was 20.00 chains (1320.00 feet). WSDOT found the distance to be 1320.88 feet between found monuments. In 1982, Rick A. Tawney of the BLM found no remaining evidence of the original corner. He set an aluminum post, 28 inches long in a mound of stone with a cap marked:

(2) FOUND:

On September 17, 2008 a WSDOT crew found a 3" diameter brass cap in an iron pipe stamped as shown in Tawney's notes. The remains of both BT's were present.


