IX.





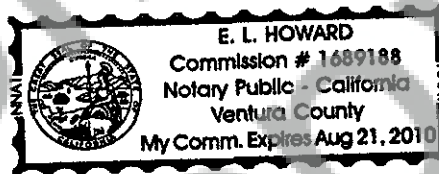
