The county may begin foreclosure proceedings as provided in RCW 84.64.050 if the compensating tax and interest remain unpaid.

If an application for reclassification is received within 30 days of this notice, no compensating tax is due until the application is denied, or, if approved, the property is later removed from classification under chapter 84.34 RCW in accordance with RCW 84.34.108.
