

Dear Mr. and Mrs. Elliott,

The Community Development Department issued a final Administrative Decision on May 14, 2009 for the above referenced application. On September 1, 2010 we received a letter from PUD No. 1 of Skamania County with your signature requesting a minor change to the approved decision. The PUD is requesting to move a misplaced PUD water line that crosses the edge of your property into the Sooter Road right-of-way. As currently located, the water line runs through the area you have proposed to design the on-site septic and drainfield.

Pursuant to SCC §22.06.080(B), a change or alteration to an approved action, if determined to be minor by the Director, may be "deemed consistent with the provisions of this Title and the findings and conclusions on the original application." The proposed request constitutes a minor change; therefore, the original decision shall be amended as stated above.

The attached utility permit (see attached page ) to this Letter Amendment shows the existing and proposed location of the waterline. The amendment is hereby approved.

All of the original conditions in the Administrative Decision are still valid and shall be complied with. As a reminder, this letter amendment needs to be recorded at the County Auditor's office prior to staff approval of the modified building permit. 
#### **APPEALS**

This Administrative Decision shall be final unless reversed or modified on appeal. A written Notice of Appeal form must be filed by an interested person within 20 days from the date hereof. Appeals are to be made to the Skamania County Hearing Examiner, P.O. Box 790, Stevenson, WA 98648. Notice of Appeal forms and mailing lists are available at the Community Development Department and must be accompanied by a \$1,300.00 nonrefundable-filing fee and a Certificate of Mailing.

The final determination of the Environmental Threshold Determination related to this underlying government action can be appealed to a court of competent jurisdiction, along with the underlying government action, only by the parties with standing to the Environmental Threshold Determination. If the underlying government action was exempt from SEPA review, this section does not apply.


