The Community Development Department issued a final Administrative Decision on May 5, 2000 for the above referenced application. On April 6, 2010 we received a letter from you requesting some changes to the approved decision. You are requesting to include three solar panels (3.7' tall  $\times$  3.2' wide) to the existing buildings roof. The development is located within the Wind River Gorge and as steep slopes rise on both sides of the existing building, it is fully screened from all

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key viewing areas by the topography. The originally building was approved with a steeped pitch metal roof; adding three small solar panels to the existing metal roof shall not create any additional impact and is consistent with the findings and conclusions on the original application.

Pursuant to SCC §22.06.080(B), a change or alteration to an approved action, if determined to be minor by the Director, may be "deemed consistent with the provisions of this Title and the findings and conclusions on the original application." The proposed request constitutes a minor change; therefore, the original decision shall be amended as stated above.

The revised elevation drawing (see attached page 5) to this Letter Amendment shows the size and location of the proposed solar panels. The amendment is hereby approved

All of the original conditions in the Administrative Decision are still valid and shall be complied with. As a reminder, this letter amendment needs to be recorded at the County Auditor's office prior to the installation. Letter Amendment

To Skamania County:

This letter is written in request of an amendment to an existing permit NSA-99-30 for a storage building constructed on May 5<sup>th</sup>, 2000 on tax lot 3-8-21-400. The Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife and the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service are requesting the amendment so three Sharp Photovoltaic Modules (Solar Panels) can be added to the existing building's roof. The solar panel model numbers are ND-N2ECUF, and each panel is 3.7 feet tall and 3.2 feet wide. The solar panels will be mounted with standing seam mounting brackets that require no drilling or modification to the existing metal roof. The solar panels will be used to convert sunlight into energy for a passive integrated transponder (PIT tag) detection array inside Shipherd Falls Ladder. This fisheries research project will benefit spring Chinook salmon and steelhead by monitoring population trends, distribution patterns, restoration efforts, and fish harvest in the Wind River Basin.






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Ruised Seam Mount.



Solar Panel Dimension


