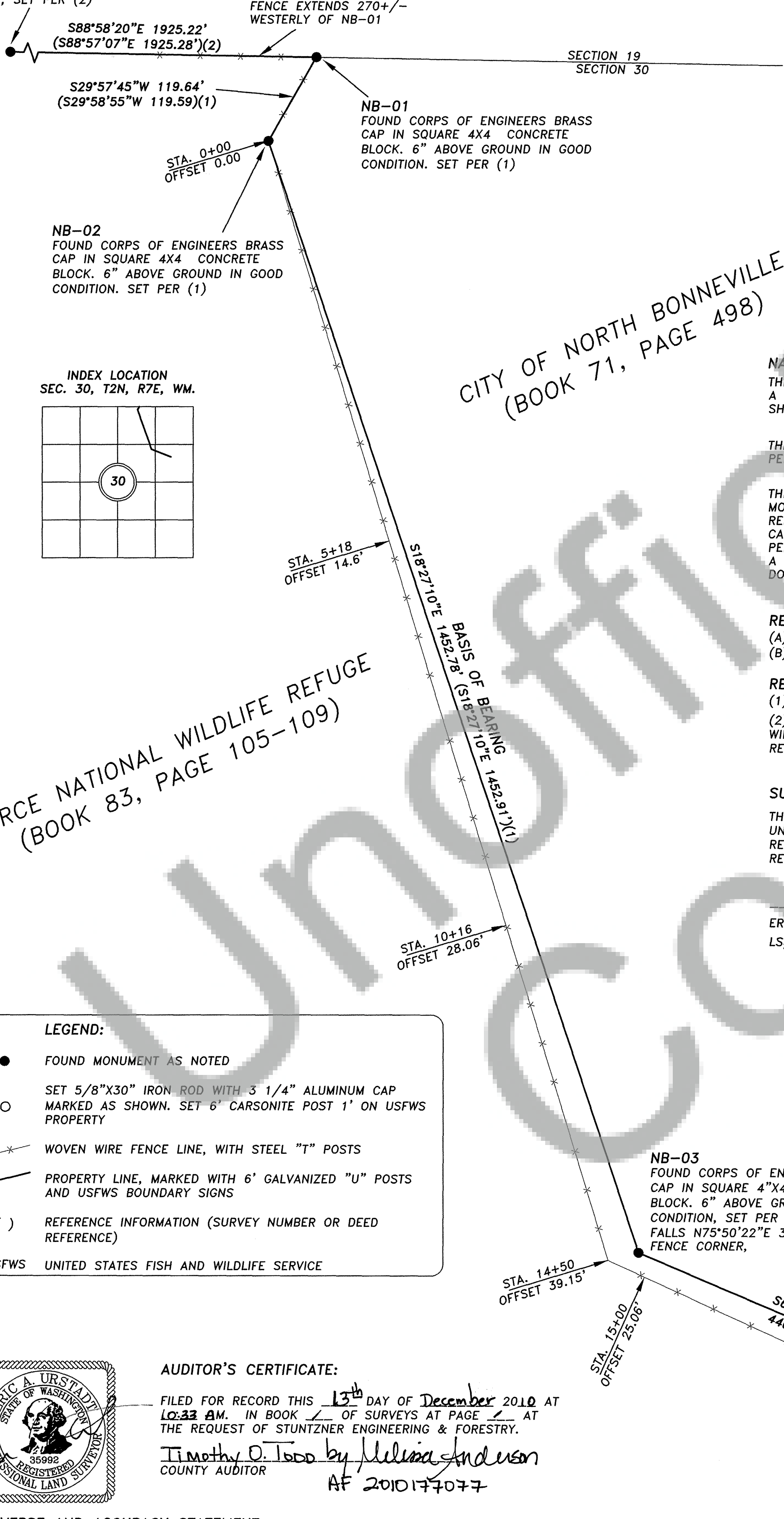


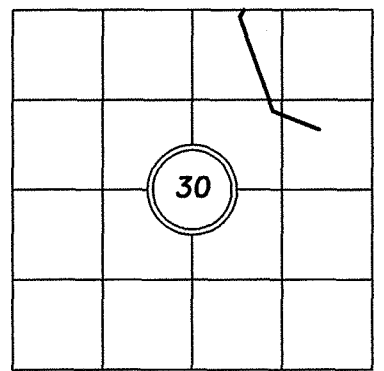

NARRATIVE:

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY WAS TO POST THE BOUNDARIES AND SET A REFERENCE MONUMENT ON THE SOUTHEASTERLY PROPERTY LINE AS SHOWN.

THE BASIS OF BEARING IS S18°27'10"E BETWEEN NB-02 AND NB-03, PER THE PLAT OF RELOCATED NORTH BONNEVILLE.

THE EAST PROPERTY LINE WAS ESTABLISHED BY HOLDING EXISTING MONUMENTS NB-01, NB-02 AND NB-03, SET IN THE PLAT OF RELOCATED NORTH BONNEVILLE. THE LINE SOUTHERLY OF NB-03 WAS CALCULATED BY HOLDING THE RECORD BEARING FROM NB-03 TO NB-02 PER PLAT OF RELOCATED NORTH BONNEVILLE. THE MONUMENT No. 6 IS A POINT-ON-LINE BECAUSE THE EASTERLY PORTIONS OF THE LINE ARE DOWN IN THE RIVER BED.

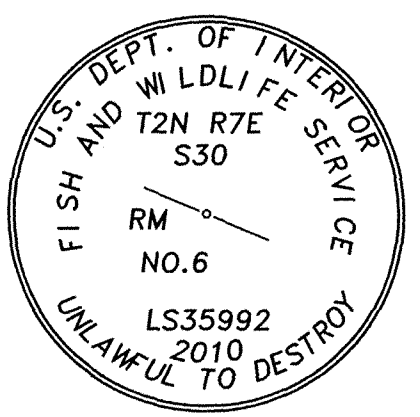

SET 5/8"x30" IRON ROD WITH 3 1/2" ALUMINUM CAP, FLUSH WITH GROUND. SET 6' CARSONITE POST 0.5' SOUTH OF MONUMENT. MONUMENT FALLS 20' NORTHWESTERLY FROM TOP OF BANK.
