

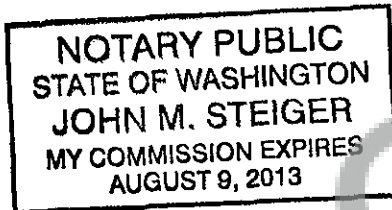

A portion of the "Prindle Park Estates" as recorded in Book A of plats, page 131, Skamania County Auditor's Records, and located in the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter and the Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 5, Township 1 North, Range 5 East, Willamette Meridian, Skamania County, Washington, described as follows

BEGINNING at a 1 inch iron pipe with brass cap marking the Southeast corner of the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 5, as shown in Book 3 of surveys, page 403, Skamania County Auditor's Records; thence North $89^{\circ}23'12''$ West, along the south line of the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter of section 5, for a distance of 749.58 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod, as shown in a 2005 "Hagedorn, Inc., Survey" and the True Point of Beginning; thence north $06^{\circ}28'15''$ east, 303 feet, more or less, to the center of Canyon Creek; thence westerly following the center of Canyon Creek, 776 feet, more or less, to the west line of the southwest quarter of the northeast quarter of section 5; thence south $01^{\circ}15'08''$ west, 220 feet, more or less, to a 1 inch iron pipe with brass cap at the center of Section 5 (2005 "Hagedorn, Inc. Survey"); thence south $01^{\circ}15'30''$ west, along the west line of the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 5, for a distance of 1327.84 feet to a 1 inch iron pipe with brass cap at the southwest corner of the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 5 (2005 "Hagedorn, Inc. Survey"); thence south $89^{\circ}23'12''$ east, 568.00 feet to the True Point of beginning.
